## EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA JANUARY 2019


The Export Price Index (XPI) decreased by 1.8 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 2.2 percent decrease in the prices for manufactured products.

Compared to January 2018 the XPI decreased by 1.6 percent. In the mentioned period prices decreased for manufactured products by 0.7 percent and for products from mining and quarrying by 7.1 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for January 2019, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
