DOMESTIC PRODUCER PRICE INDEX FOR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS IN GEORGIA FEBRUARY 2019

In February 2019 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) decreased by 0.1 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period the prices were lower by 0.1 percent for manufactured products, while for the products from mining and quarrying the prices increased by 0.3 percent.

Compared to February 2018 the DPPI increased by 3.7 percent. There was a 4.6 percent increase in the prices for manufactured products, while for electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water the prices increased by 1.1 percent.

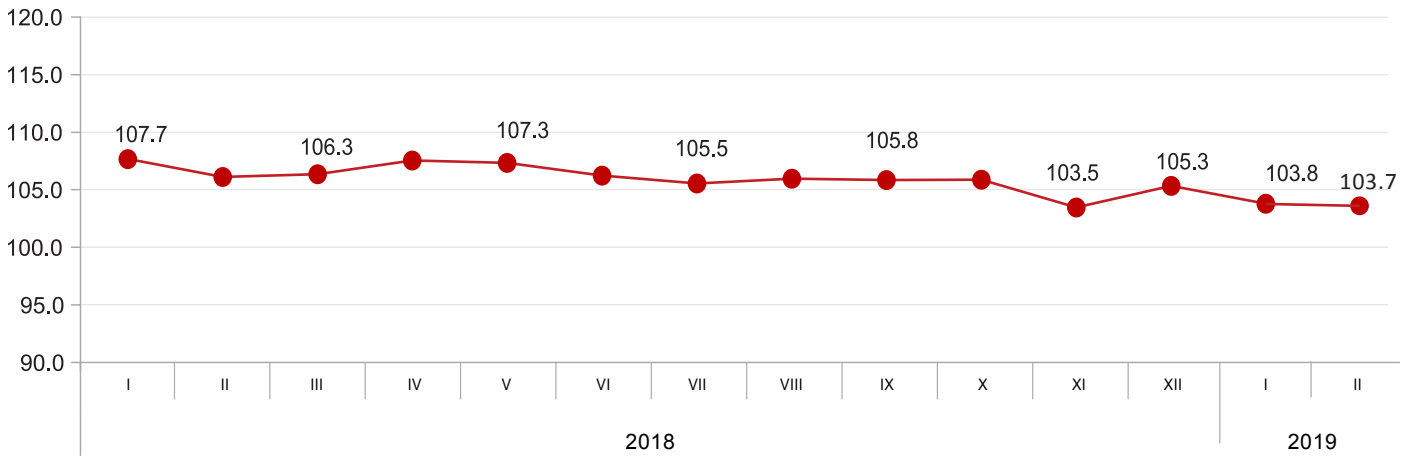
The following table shows the DPPI for February 2019, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
