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### EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA FEBRUARY 2019

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 0.5 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 0.1 percent increase in the prices for manufactured products.

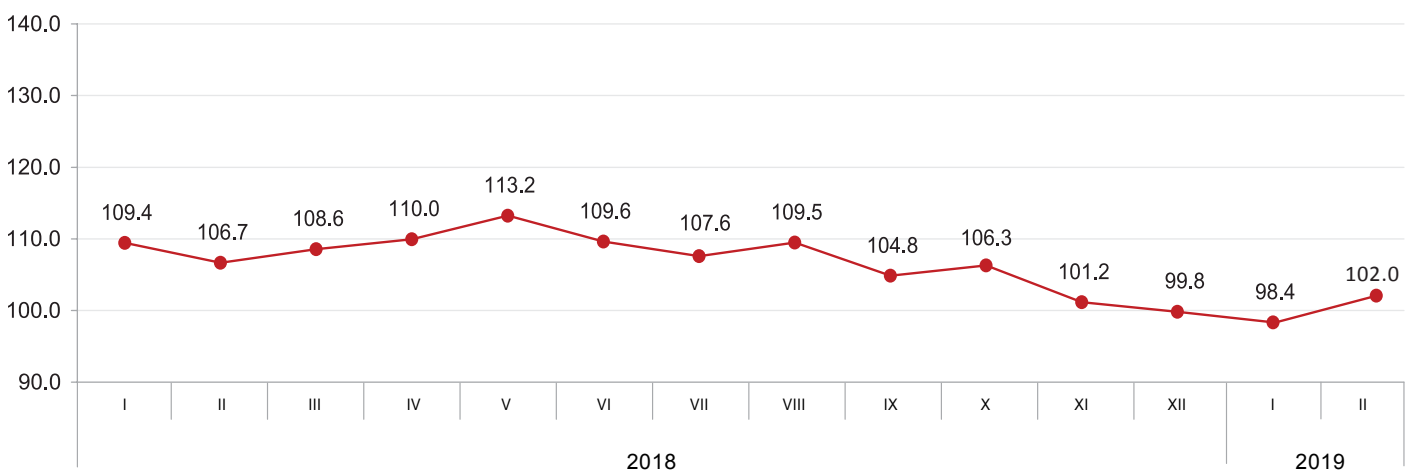
Compared to February 2018 the XPI increased by 2.0 percent. In the mentioned period the prices increased for manufactured products by 2.5 percent, while for products from mining and quarrying prices decreased by 0.4 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for February 2019, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
