### IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA FEBRUARY 2019

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 0.1 percent over the previous month, while compared to February 2018 the Index increased by 4.1 percent.

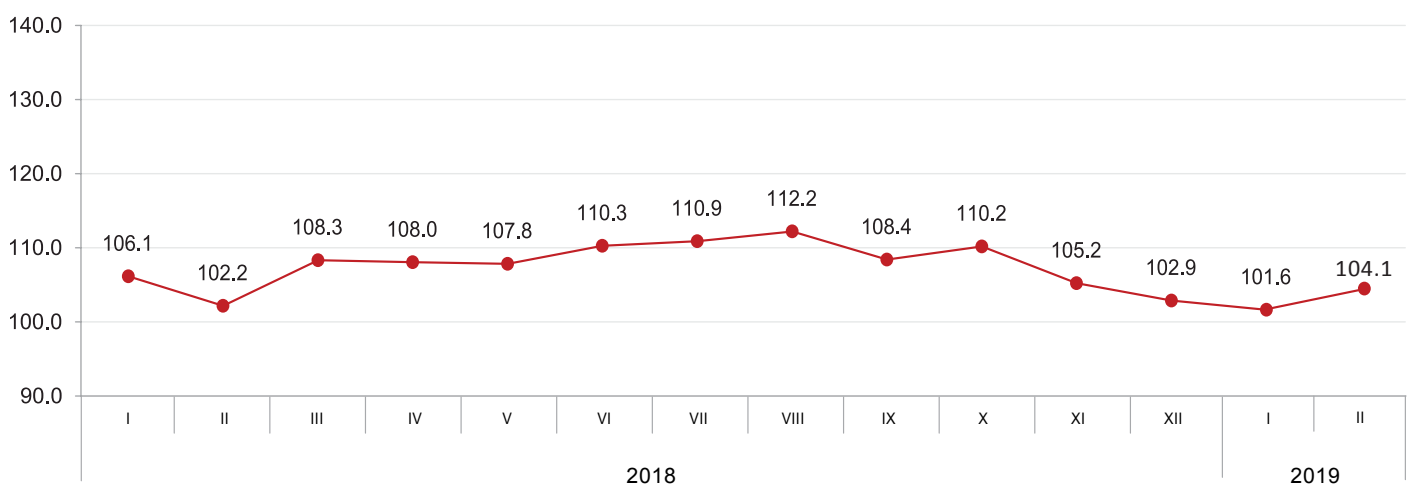
Compared to February 2018 the prices increased by 3.9 percent for manufactured products, while for products from mining and quarrying a price increase of 9.6 percent was registered. With regard to electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water, the prices decreased by 30.8 percent.

The following table shows the MPI for February 2019, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
