

Number of Population is Increasing

As of January 1, 2011 the population of Georgia increased by 32.8 thousand persons (0.7 percent) and equaled 4,469.2¹ thousand persons, of which 53.1 percent (2,371.3 thousand persons) live in urban area and 46.9 percent (2,097.9 thousand persons) in rural area.

(Thousand persons)

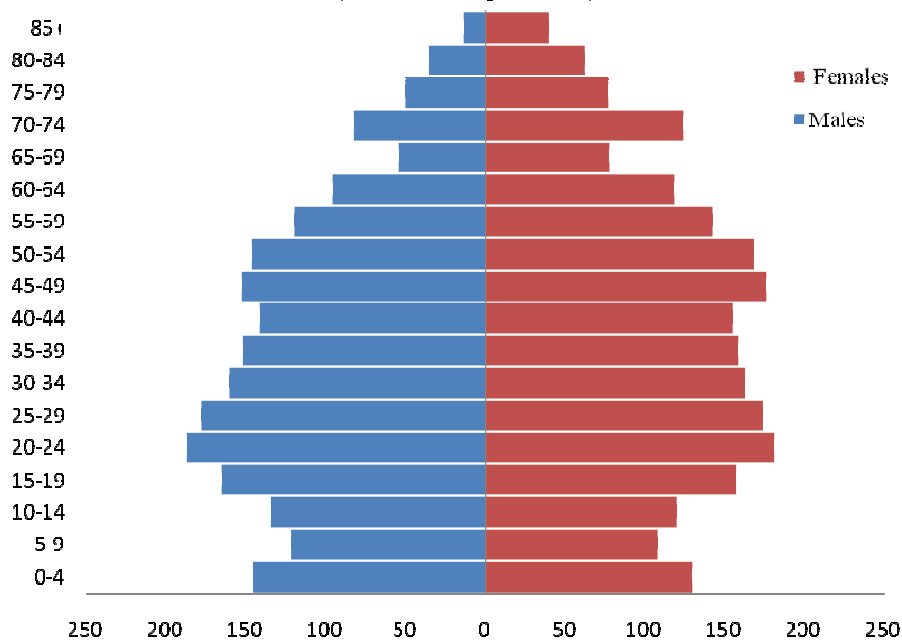
