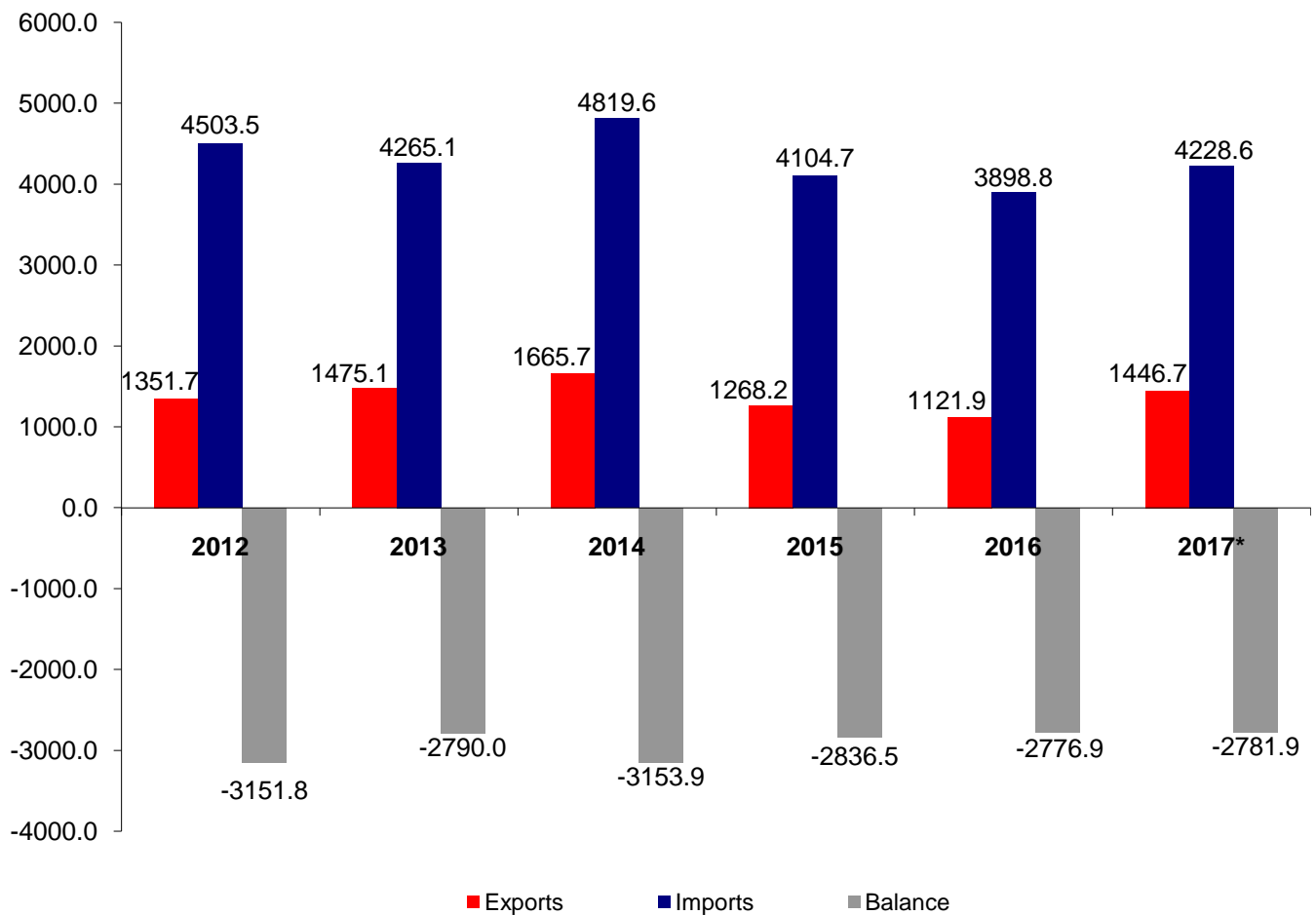

## External Trade of Georgia in January- July 2017 (Preliminary)

In January-July 2017 external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) in Georgia amounted to USD 5675.2 million, 13.0 percent higher year-on-year. The exports equaled USD 1446.7 million (28.9 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 4228.6 million (8.5 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 2781.9 million in January-July 2017 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 49.0 percent. Export excluding re-export amounted to USD 1141.6 million, 27.1 percent higher year-on-year.

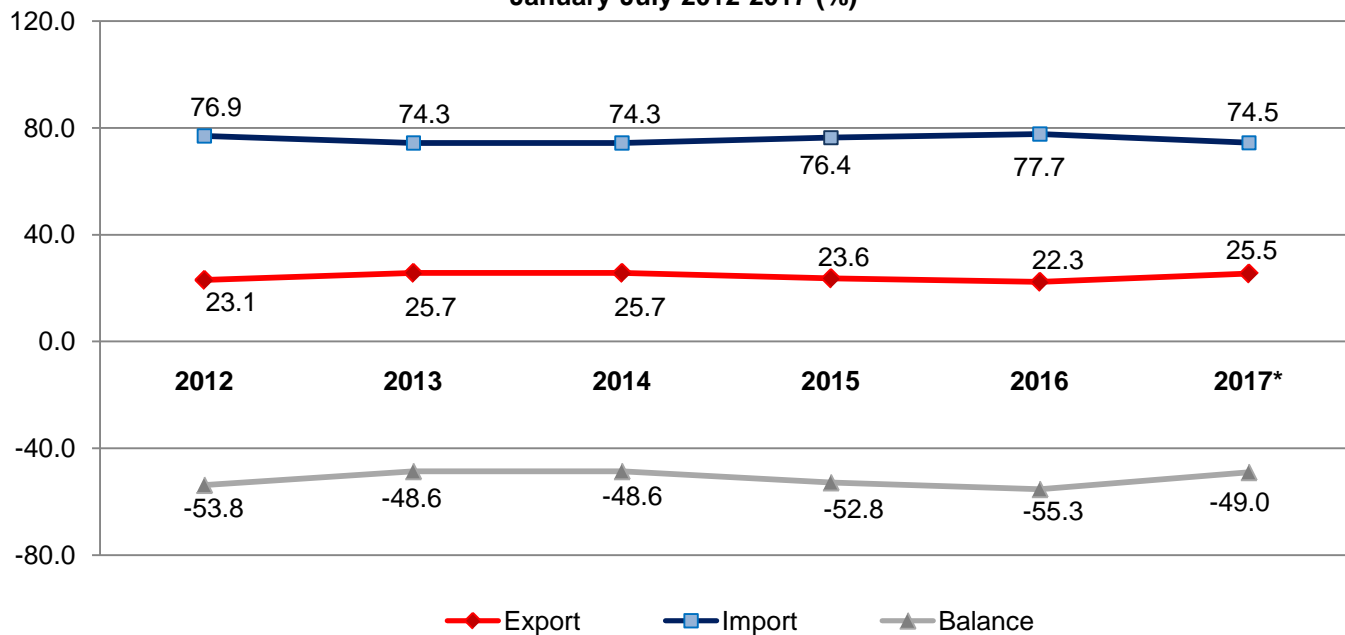

(Million US Dollars)**



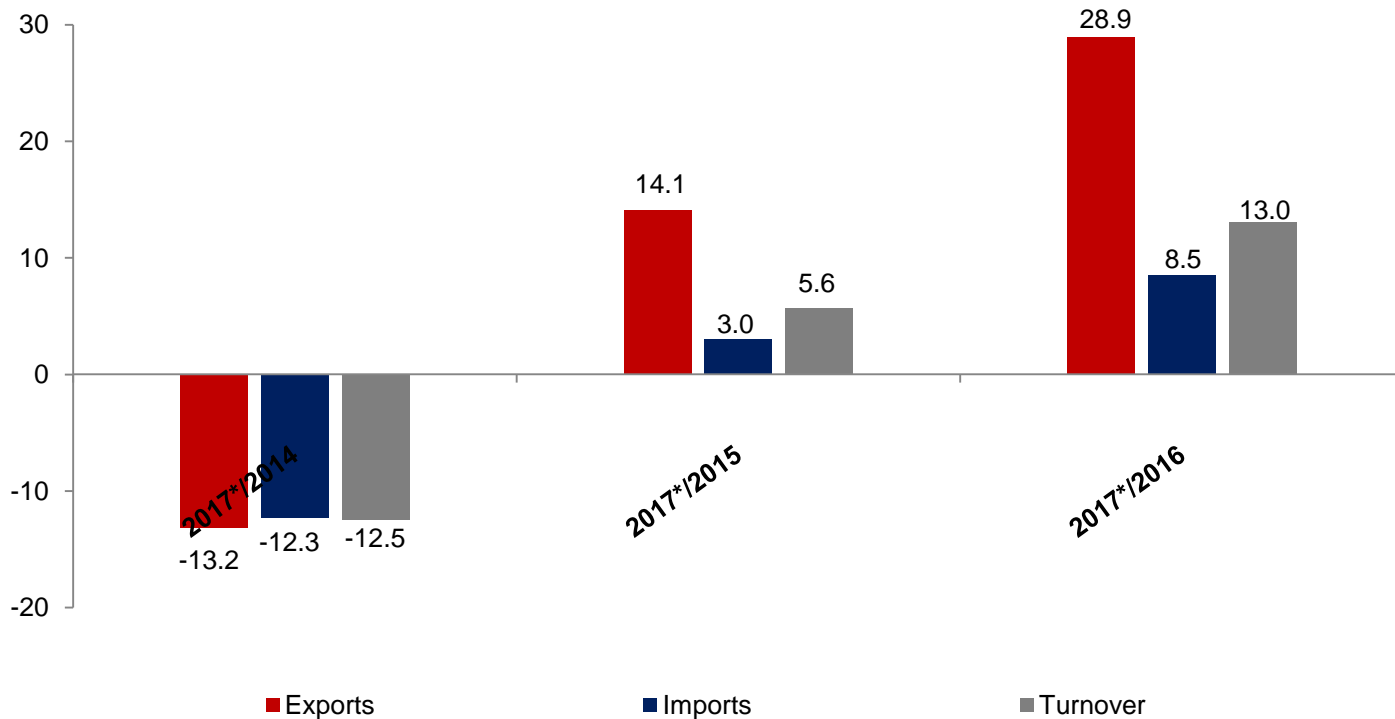

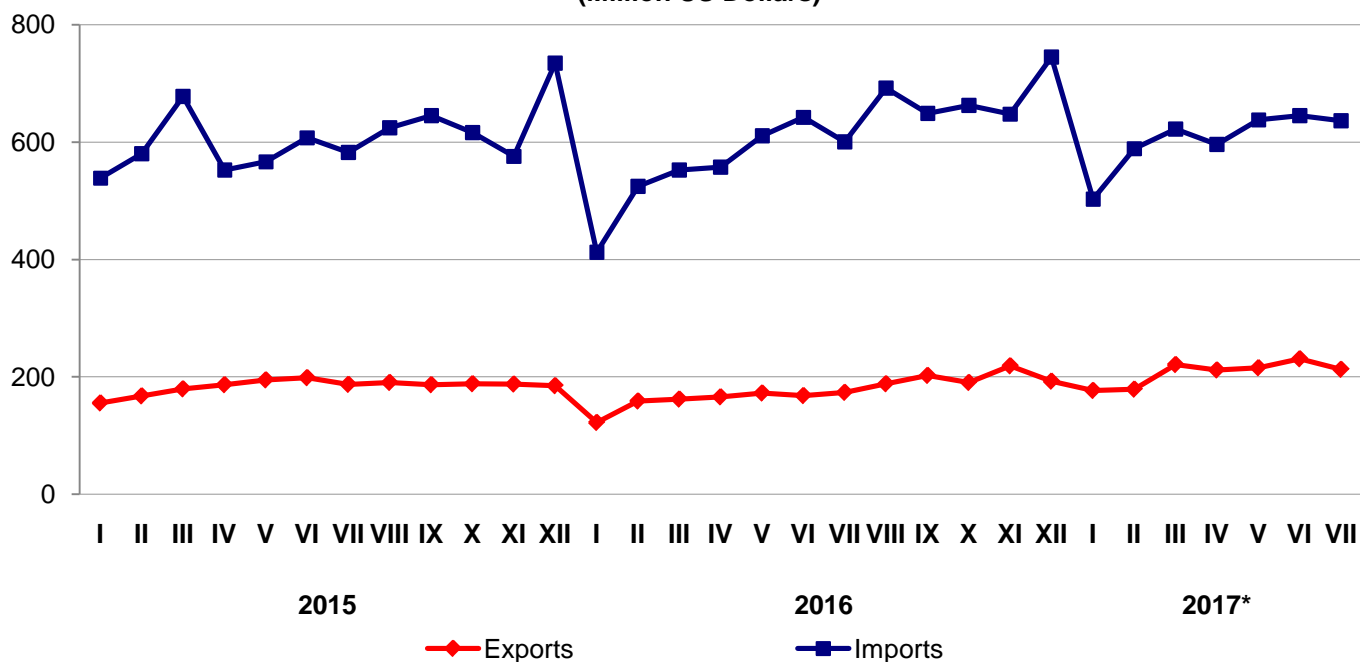

(Million US Dollars)



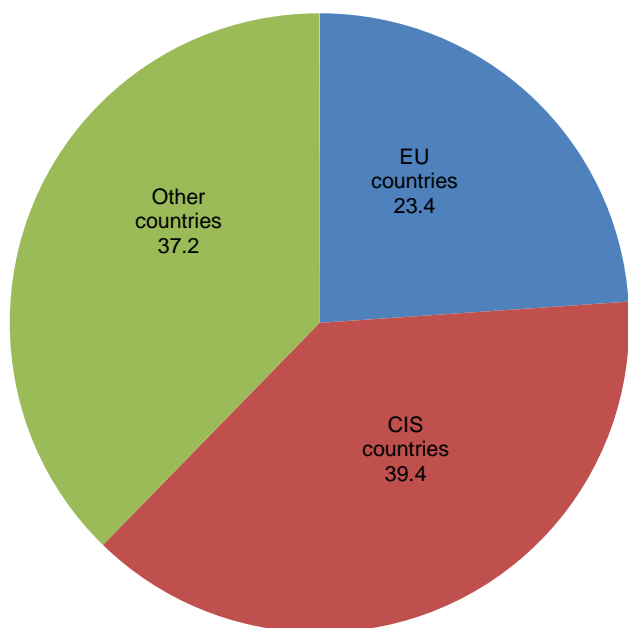

In January-July 2017 the external trade turnover of Georgia with the EU countries amounted to USD 1541.5 million, grew by 11.0 percent compared to the corresponding indicator of the previous year. Exports amounted to USD 339.1 million (33.6 percent higher), while imports amounted to USD 1202.4 million (6.0 percent higher). The share of these countries in the external trade turnover of Georgia amounted to 27.2 percent, 23.4 percent in exports and 28.4 percent in imports (in January-July 2016 27.7, 22.6 and 29.1 percent correspondingly). 31.0 percent of the trade deficit came to the EU countries (31.7 percent in January-July 2016).

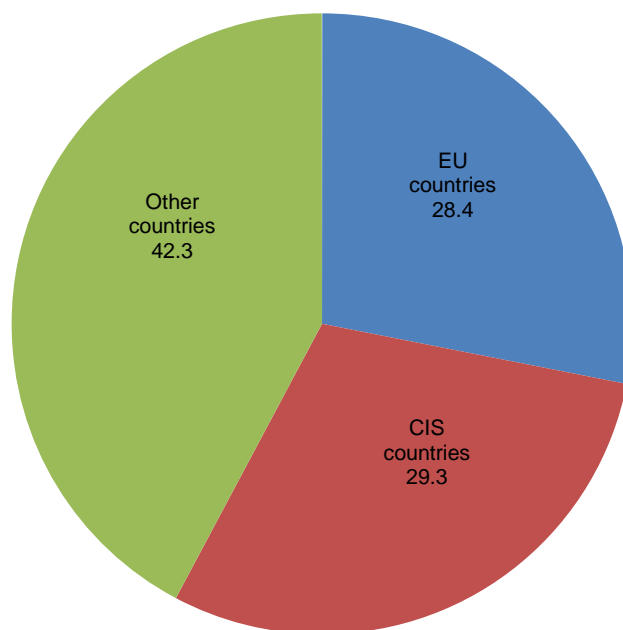
In January-July 2017 the external trade turnover of Georgia with the CIS countries totaled USD 1808.2 million (higher by 30.7 percent compared to January-July 2016). Exports stood at USD 570.3 million (59.4 percent higher), while imports equaled USD 1237.9 million (20.7 percent higher). The share of the CIS countries in the external trade turnover of Georgia constituted 31.9 percent, 39.4 percent in exports and 29.3 percent in imports (In January-July 2016 27.5, 31.9 and 26.3 percent, respectively). In January-July 2017 compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, CIS countries accounted for 24.0 percent of the overall trade deficit (24.0 percent in January-July 2016).

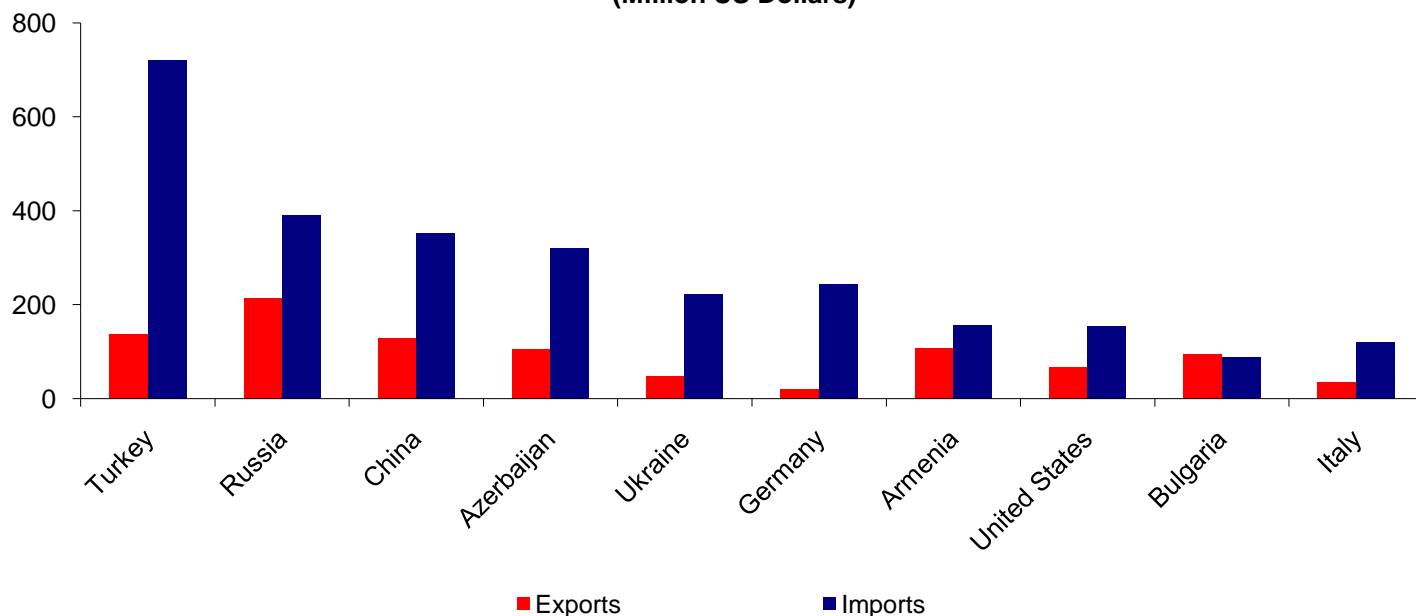
In January-July 2017 share of the top ten trading partners in the total external trade turnover of Georgia amounted to 65.8 percent. The top trading partners were Turkey (USD 858.7 million), Russia (USD 605.7 million) and China (USD 481.4 million).

(Million US Dollars)



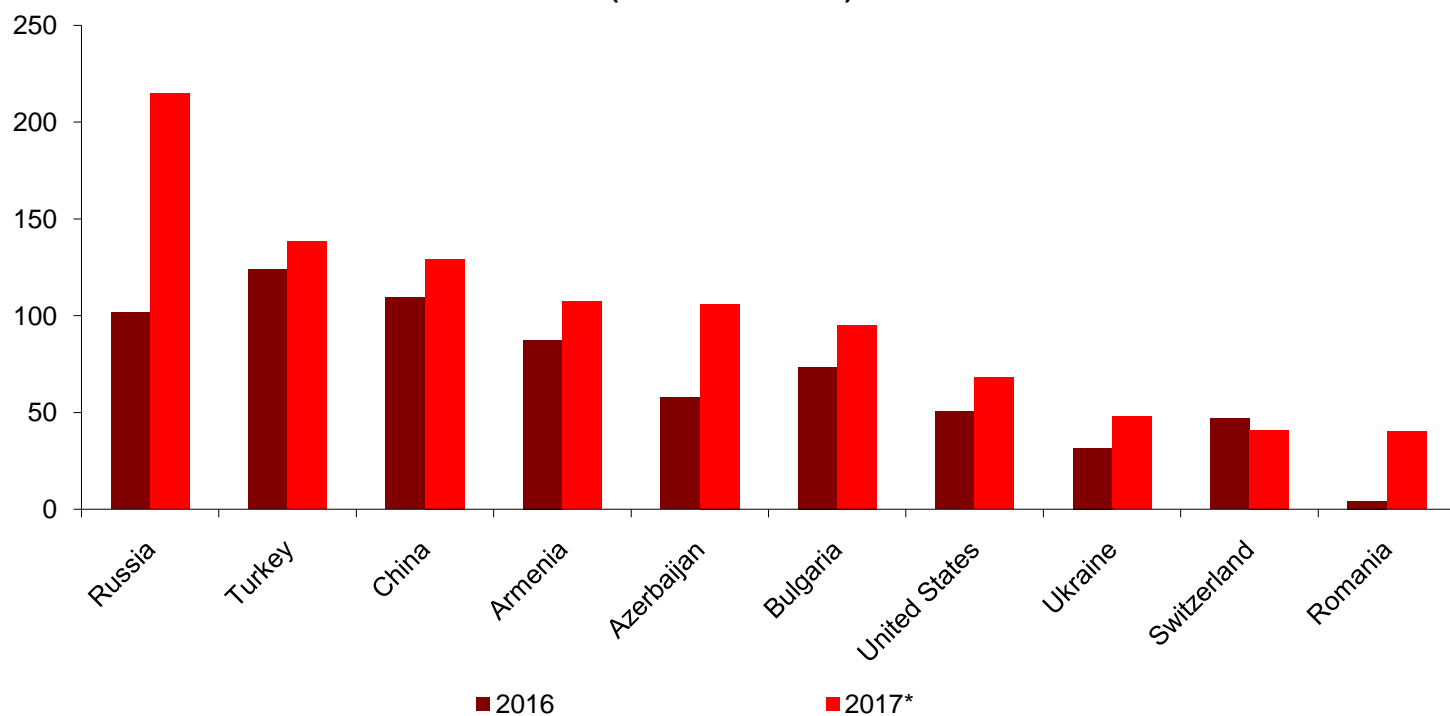

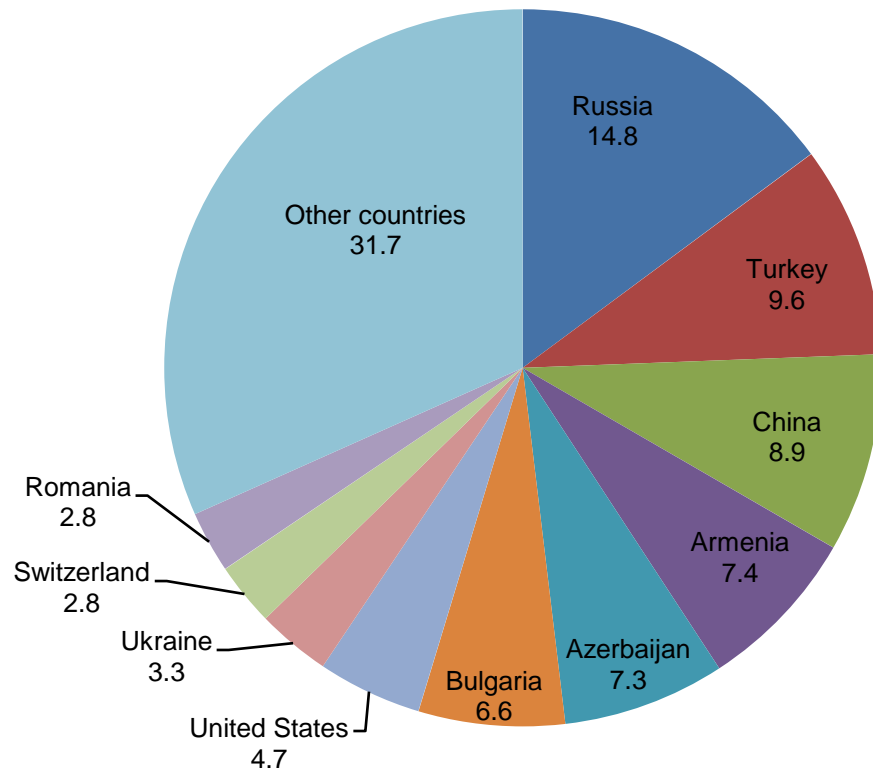

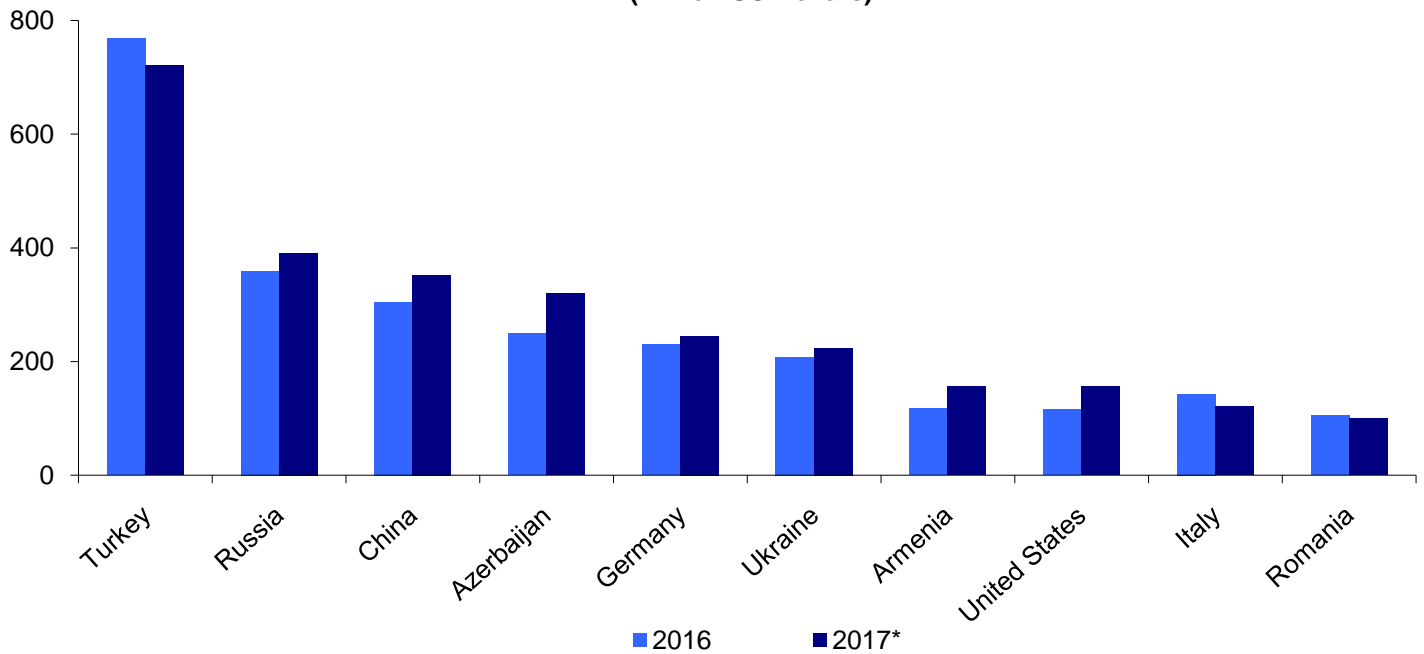

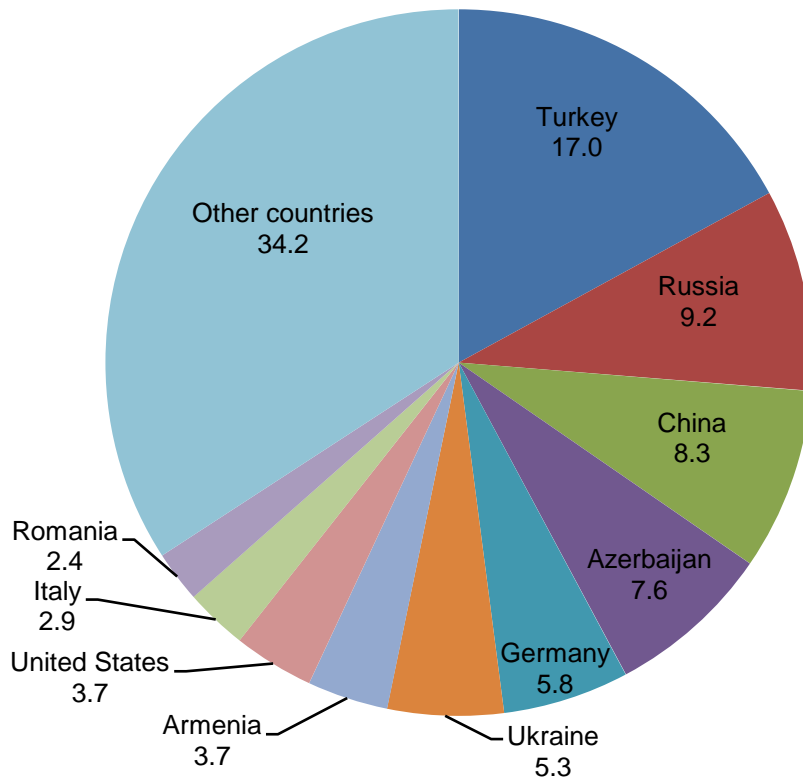


**Top trading partners by imports in January-July 2016-2017

## Major commodity groups by exports and imports

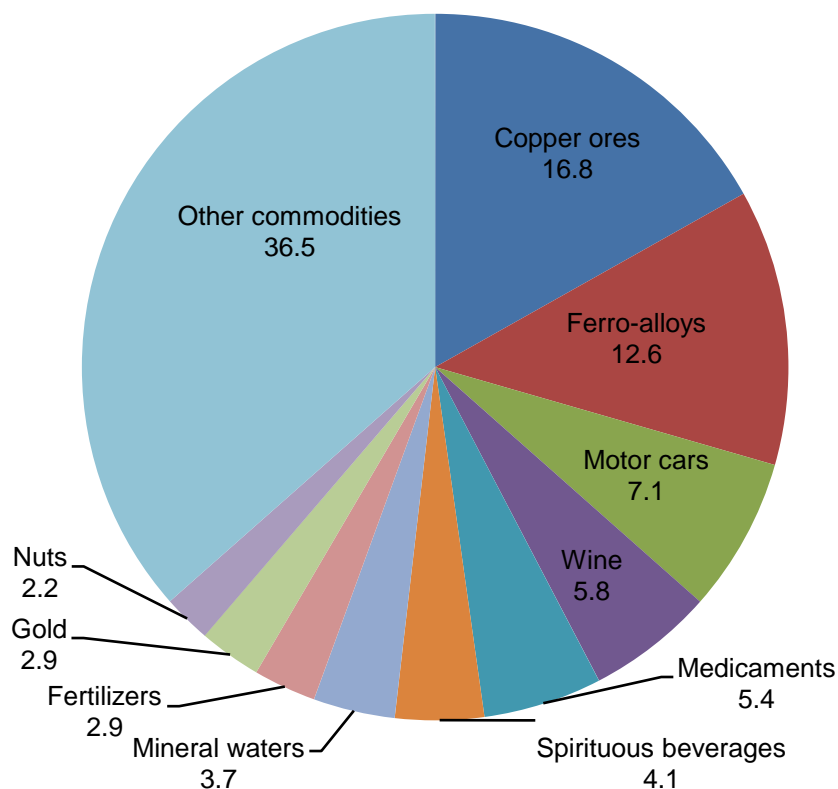
In January-July 2017 Copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 243.7 million, or 16.8 percent of total exports. Exports of Ferro-alloys totaled USD 182.5 million and its share in the total exports amounted to 12.6 percent. Motor cars occupied the third place. Exports of this commodity group stood at USD 102.4 million and 7.1 percent of the total exports.

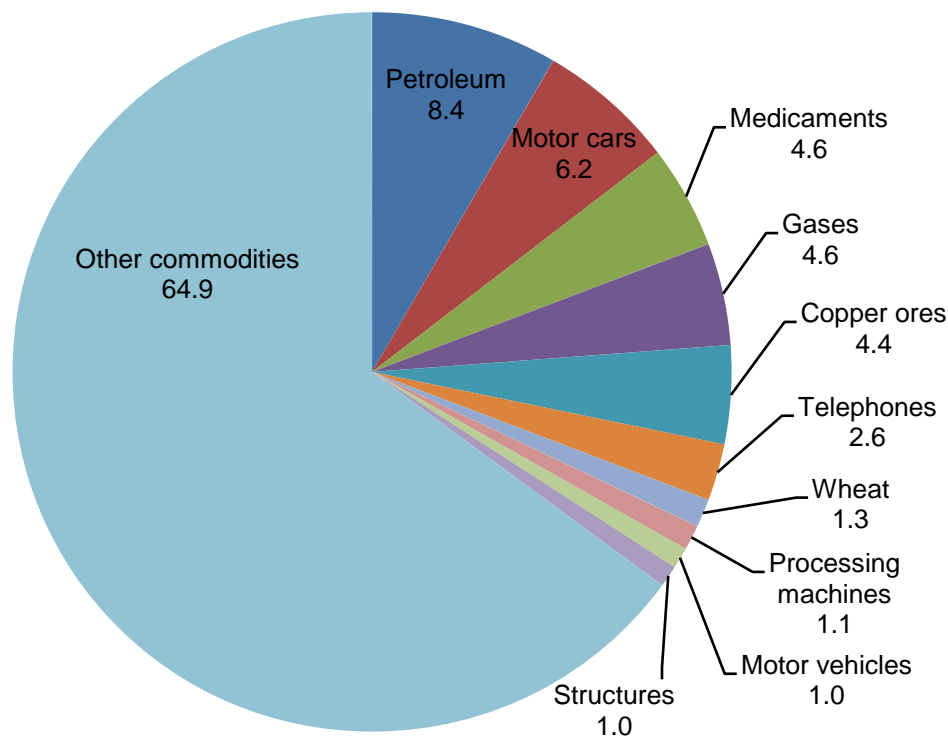
The top import commodity In January-July 2017 were Petroleum and petroleum oils, imports of which amounted to USD 354.8 million and 8.4 percent of the total imports. Motor cars commodity group followed in the list with USD 261.3 million, or 6.2 percent of imports. Medicaments came third with USD 196.6 million (4.6 percent of imports).

  3. Information does not cover the data of Simplified Customs Declarations (Form №4);
  4. According to the international methodology, there are some difference in coverage of trade flows between external merchandise trade statistics and customs statistics. Diplomatic, temporary, transit and analogous goods are excluded from the database of external merchandise trade statistics.
