

Inflation Rate in Georgia, November 2017

In November 2017 monthly inflation rate amounted to 1.1 percent. Compared to the same month of the previous year the Consumer Price Index change (annual inflation rate) posted a 6.9 percent increase.

The following table shows percentage changes in prices for the commodity groups of the consumer basket as well as the relevant contributions to the **overall monthly inflation rate**.



The monthly inflation rate was mainly influenced by price changes for the following groups:

Transport: prices in the group increased 2.8 percent and contributed 0.39 percentage points to the overall CPI change. Prices were up for purchase of vehicles (9.5 percent), transport services (4.5 percent) and operation of personal transport equipment (1.6 percent);


Food and non-alcoholic beverages increased 0.8 percent and, correspondingly, contributed 0.26 percentage points to the overall CPI change. Prices were comparably higher for the following subgroups: vegetables (6.5 percent), sugar, jam, honey, chocolate and confectionery (1.4 percent), milk, cheese and eggs (1.2 percent) and oils and fats (0.7 percent). Meanwhile, prices for fruit and grapes went down (-9.2 percent);

Alcoholic beverages and tobacco: prices were 1.7 percent higher, which had an upward effect of 0.12 percentage points on monthly inflation. Prices increased both for tobacco (1.9 percent) and alcoholic beverages (1.4 percent).

The following table shows percentage changes in prices for the commodity groups of the consumer basket as well as the relevant contributions to the **overall annual inflation rate** in November 2017.



The annual inflation rate was mainly influenced by price changes for the following groups:

Food and non-alcoholic beverages: prices increased 7.5 percent, contributing 2.24 percentage points to the annual inflation. Prices were up for the following subgroups: vegetables (25.8 percent), meat (9.9 percent), milk, cheese and eggs (9.7 percent), fruit and grapes (9.0 percent), oils and fats (7.4 percent), coffee, tea and cocoa (6.1 percent);


Transport: prices increased 15.8 percent, contributing 2.02 percentage points to the annual inflation. The prices were up for operation of personal transport equipment (18.9 percent), purchase of vehicles (18.6 percent) and transport services (8.5 percent);

Alcoholic beverages and tobacco: prices increased 19.4 percent, with a relevant contribution of 1.24 percentage points to the overall index growth. Prices within the group were higher for tobacco (40.4 percent);

Health: prices were up 6.4 percent, which resulted in a 0.55 percentage point contribution to the overall annual inflation. Prices increased for subgroups of medical products, appliances and equipment (12.2 percent) and out-patient services (6.3 percent).
