

Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products in Georgia
January 2018

In January 2018 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) increased by 2.3 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period prices increased by 14.3 percent for the group of electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water. There was a 0.4 percent increase in prices for the products from mining and quarrying and a 0.3 percent decrease in manufactured products.

Compared to January 2017 the DPPI increased by 7.7 percent. There was a 14.0 percent price increase in the prices for the group of electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water. The prices increased by 6.3 percent for manufactured products, whereas prices for products from mining and quarrying increased by 3.0 percent.

The following table shows DPPI for January 2018, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
