Export Price Index in Georgia January 2018

Export Price Index (XPI) decreased by 0.4 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period prices decreased by 0.9 percent for manufactured products, while prices for the products from mining and quarrying showed a 2.5 percent increase.


Compared to January 2017 XPI increased by 9.4 percent. The prices went up for manufactured products by 8.6 percent and for the products from mining and quarrying by 15.5 percent.

The following table shows XPI for January 2018, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
