

Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products in Georgia
February 2018

In February 2018 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) decreased by 0.04 percent **compared to the previous month**. In the mentioned period prices decreased by 0.2 percent for manufactured products. There was a 0.3 percent increase in prices for the group of electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water and a 0.8 percent price increase in the products from mining and quarrying

Compared to February 2017 the DPPI increased by 6.1 percent. There was a 4.8 percent increase in the prices for the group of manufactured products. The prices increased by 11.6 percent for electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water and by 3.6 percent for the products from mining and quarrying.

The following table shows DPPI for February 2018, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
