

*Export Price Index in Georgia
February 2018*

Export Price Index (XPI) decreased by 3.1 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period prices decreased by 3.0 percent for manufactured products and by 3.7 percent for the products from mining and quarrying.

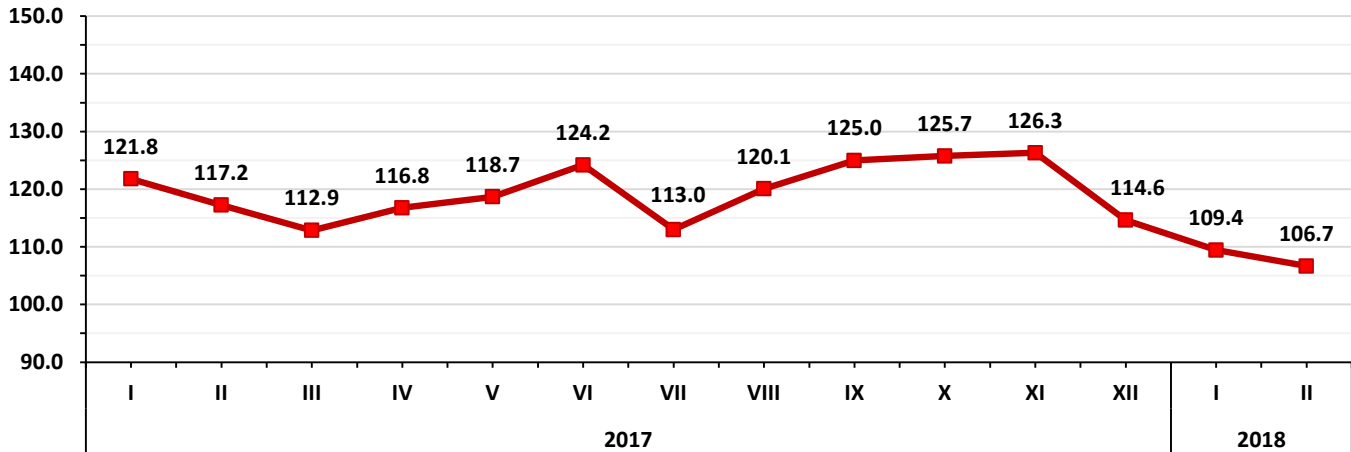
Compared to February 2017 XPI increased by 6.7 percent. The prices increased for manufactured products by 6.2 percent and for the products from mining and quarrying by 9.4 percent.

The following table shows XPI for February 2018, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
