

Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products in Georgia

May 2018

In May 2018 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) decreased by 0.03 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period prices decreased by 1.3 percent for electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water, while the prices increased by 0.3 percent for manufactured products.

Compared to May 2017 the DPPI increased by 7.3 percent. There was a 5.5 percent increase in the prices for the group of manufactured products. The prices increased by 15.2 percent for electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water and by 7.6 percent for the products from mining and quarrying.

The following table shows the DPPI for May 2018, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
