EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA AUGUST 2018

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 5.1 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 5.9 percent increase in the prices for manufactured products.

Compared to August 2017 the XPI increased by 9.5 percent. In the mentioned period prices increased for manufactured products by 11.1 percent, while for products from mining and quarrying prices decreased by 0.5 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for August 2018, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
