IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA SEPTEMBER 2018

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 2.8 percent over the previous month, while compared to September 2017 the index increased by 8.4 percent.

Compared to September 2017 the prices increased by 11.3 percent for manufactured products, while for products from mining and quarrying a price decrease of 11.1 percent was registered. With regard to electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water, the prices increased by 5.3 percent.

The following table shows the MPI for September 2018, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
