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


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EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-OCTOBER 2018 (PRELIMINARY)

In January-October 2018 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 10 305.9 million, 20.5 percent higher year-on-year. The exports equaled USD 2 751.0 million (24.5 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 7 555.0 million (19.2 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 4 804.0 million in January-October 2018 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 46.6 percent. The exports excluding re-exports amounted to USD 1 912.1 million, 12.0 percent higher year-on-year.



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

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In January-October 2018 the exports from Georgia to the EU countries amounted to USD 599.7 million (11.1 percent higher compared to the January-October 2017) and constituted 21.8 percent in total exports, while the imports amounted to USD 2 169.9 million (20.9 percent higher) with 28.7 percent in total imports. The external trade turnover of Georgia with the EU countries amounted to USD 2 769.7 million, grew by 18.6 percent compared to the corresponding indicator of the previous year. 32.7 percent of the trade deficit came to the EU countries.


In January-October 2018 the exports to the CIS countries stood at USD 1 315.2 million (43.7 percent higher compared to the January-October 2017) and reached 47.8 percent of total exports, while the imports equaled USD 2 197.2 million (19.4 percent higher) with 29.1 percent in total import. The trade turnover with the CIS countries totaled USD 3 512.4 million (higher by 27.4 percent). The CIS countries accounted for 18.4 percent of the overall trade deficit in the corresponding period.

The diagrams below show the share of the exports and imports of Georgia by country groups.





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
In January-October 2018 the share of the top ten trading partners by exports in the total exports of Georgia amounted to 71.8 percent. The top partners were Azerbaijan (USD 386.0 million), Russia (USD 351.9 million) and Armenia (USD 226.0 million).




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TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-OCTOBER 2017-2018 (MILLION US DOLLARS)



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

The top trading partners were Turkey (USD 1 422.1 million), Russia (USD 1 128.9 million) and China (USD 903.4 million).




In January-October 2018 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 423.9 million, or 15.4 percent of total exports. The exports of motor cars totaled USD 316.6 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 11.5 percent. The ferroalloys exports occupied the third place standing at USD 301.3 million and constituting 11.0 percent of the total exports.

The top import commodities in January-October 2018 were petroleum and petroleum oils whose imports equaled USD 730.0 million (9.7 percent of the total imports). The motor cars followed in the list with USD 492.0 million, or 6.5 percent of imports. The copper ores and concentrates were third in the top import commodity list with USD 338.3 million (4.5 percent of imports).





- 3. Information does not cover the data of Simplified Customs Declarations (Form №4);

4. Information does not cover non-organized trade, also occupied territories of Abkhazian Autonomous Republic and Tskhinvali region;

5. According to the international methodology, there are some difference in coverage of trade flows between external merchandise trade statistics and customs statistics. Diplomatic, temporary, transit and analogous goods are excluded from the database of external merchandise trade statistics.

The preliminary data will be revised according to the Geostat's revision policy (based on the regular revision principle) as a result of adjusting data by respondents/administrative sources.

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
