EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA NOVEMBER 2018

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 0.9 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 0.9 percent increase in the prices for manufactured products.

Compared to November 2017 the XPI increased by 1.2 percent. In the mentioned period the prices increased for manufactured products by 2.6 percent, while the prices for products from mining and quarrying decreased by 8.1 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for November 2018, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
