
#### **EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-APRIL 2019**

(PRELIMINARY)

In January-April 2019 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 3 859.6 million, 2.3 percent higher year-on-year. The exports equaled USD 1 133.4 million (17.9 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 2 726.2 million (3.1 percent lower). The negative trade balance was USD 1 592.8 million in January-April 2019 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 41.3 percent. The exports excluding re-exports amounted to USD 739.9 million, 8.4 percent higher year-on-year.





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## EXPORTS AND IMPORTS DYNAMICS BY MONTHS, 2017-2019 (MILLION US DOLLARS)




In January-April 2019 the exports from Georgia to the EU countries amounted to USD 276.2 million (14.3 percent higher compared to January-April 2018) and constituted 24.4 percent of total exports, while the imports amounted to USD 709.7 million (14.7 percent lower) with 26.0 percent in total imports. The external trade turnover of Georgia with the EU countries amounted to USD 985.9 million, showing a 8.2 percent decrease compared to the corresponding indicator of the previous year. The EU countries accounted for 27.2 percent of the trade deficit.

In January-April 2019 the exports to the CIS countries stood at USD 576.5 million (34.1 percent higher compared to January-April 2018) and reached 50.9 percent of total exports, while the imports equaled USD 773.4 million (11.8 percent lower) with 28.4 percent in total import. The trade turnover with the CIS countries totaled USD 1 350.0 million (3.3 percent higher). The CIS countries accounted for 12.4 percent of the overall trade deficit in the corresponding period.

The diagrams below show the share of the exports and imports of Georgia by country groups.



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In January-April 2019 the share of the top ten trading partners by exports in the total exports of Georgia amounted to 74.1 percent. The top partners were Russia (USD 177.5 million), Azerbaijan (USD 126.3 million) and Bulgaria (USD 109.0 million).




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# TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-APRIL 2018-2019 (MILLION US DOLLARS)

In January-April 2019 the share of the top ten trading partners by imports in the total imports of Georgia amounted to 66.5 percent. The top partners were Turkey (USD 447.0 million), China (USD 273.5 million) and Russia (USD 269.1 million).




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## TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-APRIL 2018-2019 (MILLION US DOLLARS)

In January-April 2019 the share of the top ten trading partners in the total external trade turnover of Georgia amounted to 67.7 percent. The top trading partners were Turkey (USD 525.1 million), Russia (USD 446.6 million) and Azerbaijan (USD 362.1 million).



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#### TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY TURNOVER IN JANUARY-APRIL 2019\* (MILLION US DOLLARS)



In January-April 2019 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 195.3 million or 17.2 percent of total exports. The exports of motor cars totaled USD 149.3 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 13.2 percent. The ferro-alloys exports occupied the third place standing at USD 117.3 million and constituting 10.3 percent of the total exports.



The top import commodities in January-April 2019 were petroleum and petroleum oils whose imports equaled USD 211.4 million (7.8 percent of the total imports). The Copper ores and concentrates followed in the list with USD 194.5 million, or 7.1 percent of imports. The motor cars were third in the top import commodity list with USD 180.2 million (6.6 percent of imports).





- 4. Information does not cover non-organized trade, also occupied territories of Abkhazian Autonomous Republic and Tskhinvali region;
- 5. According to the international methodology, there are some difference in coverage of trade flows between external merchandise trade statistics and customs statistics. Diplomatic, temporary, transit and analogous goods are excluded from the database of external merchandise trade statistics.

The preliminary data will be revised according to the Geostat's revision policy (based on the regular revision principle) as a result of adjusting data by respondents/administrative sources.

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
