
HOUSEHOLDS INCOMES AND EXPENDITURES

(2018)



The average monthly incomes (cash and non-cash inflows) of the population in Georgia, in 2018 amounted to 1,187.2 million GEL, which is 0.5 percent increase compared to 2017 year.

AVERAGE MONTHLY CASH AND NON-CASH INFLOWS OF THE POPULATION FOR 2010-2018 YEARS




According to the survey data of 2018, average monthly incomes (cash and non-cash inflows) equals to 1,123.5 GEL per household and 318.3 GEL per capita.




According to the survey, the main source of incomes for households are cash incomes and transfers, which increased by 3.4 percent point y.o.y and reached 83.0 percent.


The amount of households total incomes (cash and non-cash inflows) in urban area is significantly higher and equals to 760.7 million GEL. The same indicator for rural area amounted to 426.5 million GEL.

In 2018 year, the income from wages (49.7 percent) and self-employment (11.4 percent) has a significant contribution in the structure of cash incomes and transfers. Additionally, pensions, scholarships, assistances and money received as gift holds considerable share - 17.9 percent and 9.0 percent correspondingly.

PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF CASH INCOMES AND TRANSFERS IN 2018 YEAR





In 2018 year, the average monthly expenditures of Georgian population amounted to 1,164.5 million GEL, which is 0.1 percent decrease in comparison to the last year.

AVERAGE MONTHLY EXPENDITURES OF THE TOTAL POPULATION IN 2010-2018 YEARS




According to the survey the average monthly expenditures per household is equal to 1,102 GEL, while the average monthly expenditures per capita amounted to 312.2 GEL.

AVERAGE MONTHLY EXPENDITURES PER HOUSEHOLD AND PER CAPITA IN 2010-2018 YEARS




In 2018 year, the share of household cash consumption expenditure in total expenditure decreased by 0.6 percent points compared to 2017 year and equals to 66.8 percent.

DISTRIBUTION OF AVERAGE MONTLY EXPENDITURES BY THE MAIN CATEGORIES IN 2010-2018 YEARS




Similarly, as for households incomes, the amount of households expenditures in urban area is considerably higher and equals to 749.5 million GEL. The same indicator for rural area amounted to 415 million GEL.

In 2018 year, expenditures on food, beverages, tobacco (37.4 percent) has a significant share in the structure of the cash consumption expenditure, which is shown in the chart below:
