### DOMESTIC PRODUCER PRICE INDEX FOR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS IN GEORGIA

JUNE 2019

In June 2019 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) increased by 0.7 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period the prices were 0.6 percent higher for manufactured products.

Compared to June 2018 the DPPI increased by 5.5 percent. The prices went up for manufactured products and for products from mining and quarrying by 8.6 and 5.1 percent, respectively. Meanwhile, the prices for electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water decreased by 8.6 percent.

The following table shows the DPPI for June 2019, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.

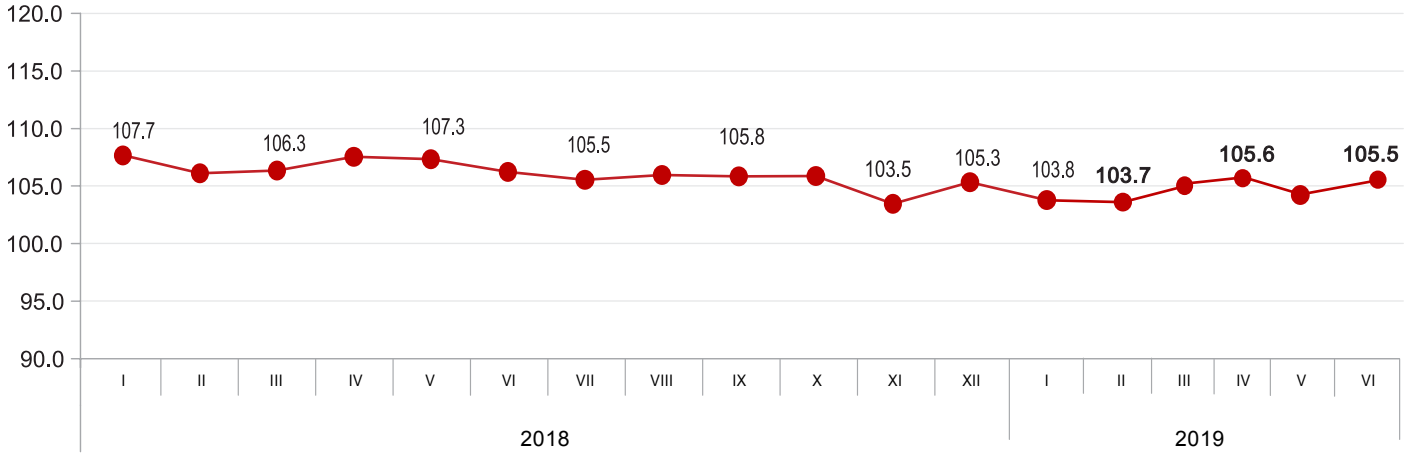
