

In the Year 2018 compared to the previous year the volume of business sector turnover increased by 20.7 percent and amounted to 86.6 billion GEL.

The production value of the business sector is characterized by the growth tendency. In the Year 2018, its volume equaled to 41.6 billion GEL, which is year-on-year 9.0 percent higher:

CHANGE IN THE VOLUME OF BUSINESS SECOTRE TURNOVER AND PRODUCTION VALUE BY YEARS







In the Year 2018, 49.5 percent of total turnover comes on large and 21.4 percent - on medium businesses while 29.1 percent is distributed to small business.

A small difference is in case of total production value: 40.4 percent comes on large, 26.6 percent – on medium and 33.0 percent on small businesses.

In the Year 2018, total purchases of goods and services carried out by enterprises equaled to 56.7 billion GEL (year-on-year 11.6 percent higher), while the purchase goods and services for resale amounted 35.9 billion GEL (year-on-year 13.6 percent higher).


In the Year 2018, the average number of employees equaled to 734.2 thousand, which is year-on-year 3.7 percent higher. Out of the total number of employees, 40.2 percent are female and 59.8 percent are male.

33.1 percent of total number of employees comes on large, 21.8 percent – on medium and 45.1 percent - on small businesses.

The total number of employed persons amounted 679.5 thousands (year-on-year 4.1 percent higher). The total personnel costs of enterprises equaled to 9 046.4 million GEL (year-on-year 12.4 percent higher).

In the Year 2018, average monthly remuneration of employed persons equaled to 1 101.3 GEL (year-on-year increase by 81.6 GEL) while remuneration of employed women made up 835.3 GEL (year-on-year increase by 71.0 GEL). Average monthly remuneration of employed persons by size of enterprises is as follows:

- Large business 1 224.6 GEL
- Medium business 1 276.3 GEL
- Small business 892.4 GEL



In the Year 2018, the trade sector (including repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles) has the highest share (43.2 percent) in the total turnover in business sector, followed by arts, entertainment and recreation with 16.1 percent share, manufacturing - 10.6 percent, construction - 8.3 percent, transportation and storage – 5.8 percent, electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – 3.8 percent and other sectors with 12.2 percent share:

TURNOVER IN BUSINESS SECTOR, 2019




In the Year 2018, manufacturing (21.9 percent), construction (18.7 percent), trade (16.5 percent) and transportation and storage (9.7 percent) are on the top four places in business sector production value. Rest of sectors have the 33.2 percent share:

PRODUCTION VALUE IN BUSINESS SECTOR, 2018




In the Year 2018, trade (wholesale and retail trade, repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles), manufacturing and construction are leading in business sector by number of employees (accordingly with 26.8 percent, 12.7 percent and 10.1 percent share). However, enterprises engaged in Human health and social work activities (9.9 percent), transportation and storage (7.9 percent) and accommodation and food service activities (6.2 percent) have also a significant share:

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN BUSINESS SECTOR, 2018




By regions, Tbilisi and following regions are leading in gross turnover:

- Tbilisi 64.2 percent
- Adjara 8.5 percent
- Kvemo Kartli 7.7 percent
- Imereti 6.1 prcent
- Samegrelo-Zemo svaneti 3.8 percent

The chart bellow shows turnover and production value by region, exept Tbilisi (in mln GEL):




