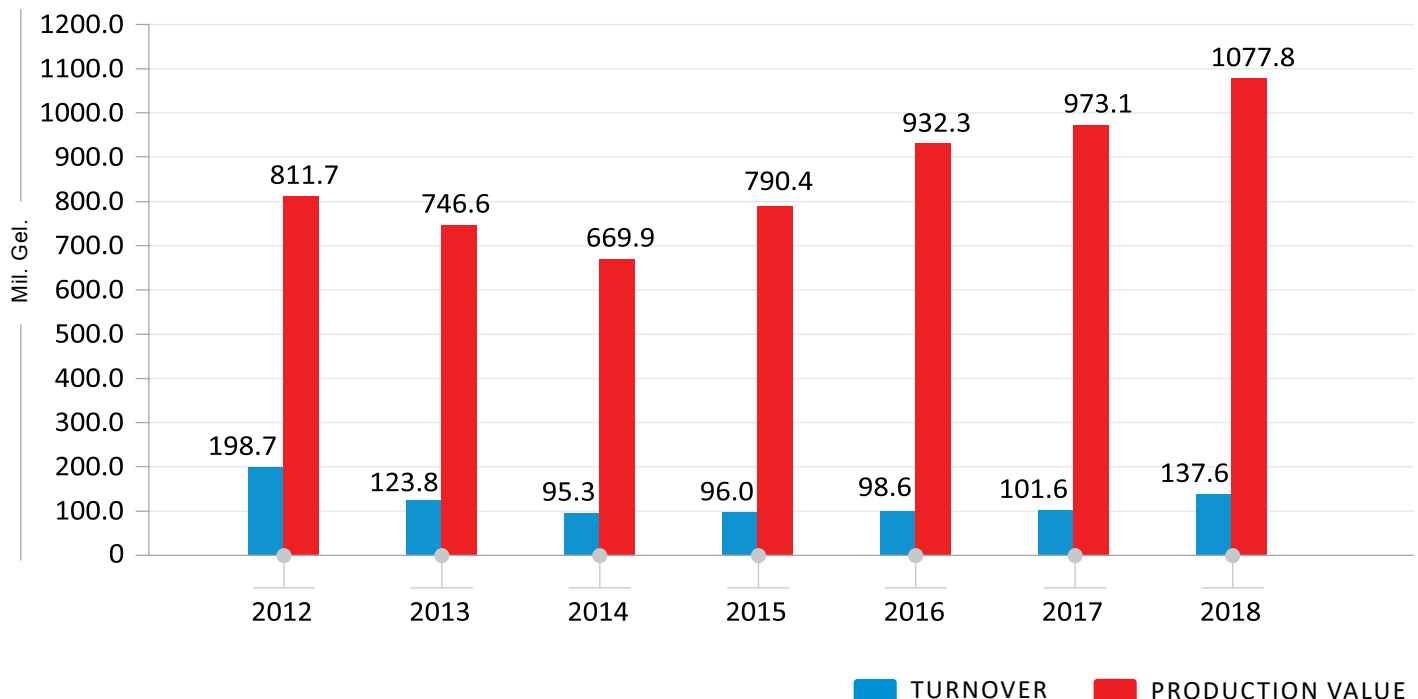
(COMPARISONS ARE MADE BY ACTUAL PRICES)

The Non-profit institutions are legal entities or organizations which produce goods and services and are not focused to receive financial profit. The main part of goods and services produced by Non-profit institutions are distributed free of charge or in not significant prices. The mentioned organizations mostly are on self-financing or membership fees. The financial and non-financial assets can be considered as income of Non-profit institutions. They are encouraged to make an additional economic activity.

By the declared data of 2018 the turnover from auxiliary activities of Non-profit institutions has been amounted 137.6 mil. Georgian Lari, Which 35.5% higher compared to previous year:

TUROVER AND PRODUCTION VALUE OF NON-PROFIT INSITURIONS

The biggest share in entire structure of turnover belongs to education (36.9%) Health care and social work (23.7%), arts, entertainment and recreation (18.3%), other services (8.7%), professional, scientific and technical activities (5.0%) and information and communication activities (4.1%).

Turnover increased about 8.2 times in the administrative and support services activities, 2 times in the education activities, 1.9 times in the real estate activities, 39.4 % in the information and communications activities, 29.4% in the construction activities, and 26.0 % in the health and social services sector.

The production value (of goods and services) of Non-profit institutions has been amounted 1077.8 mil. Georgian Lari, Which 10.8% higher compared to previous year.

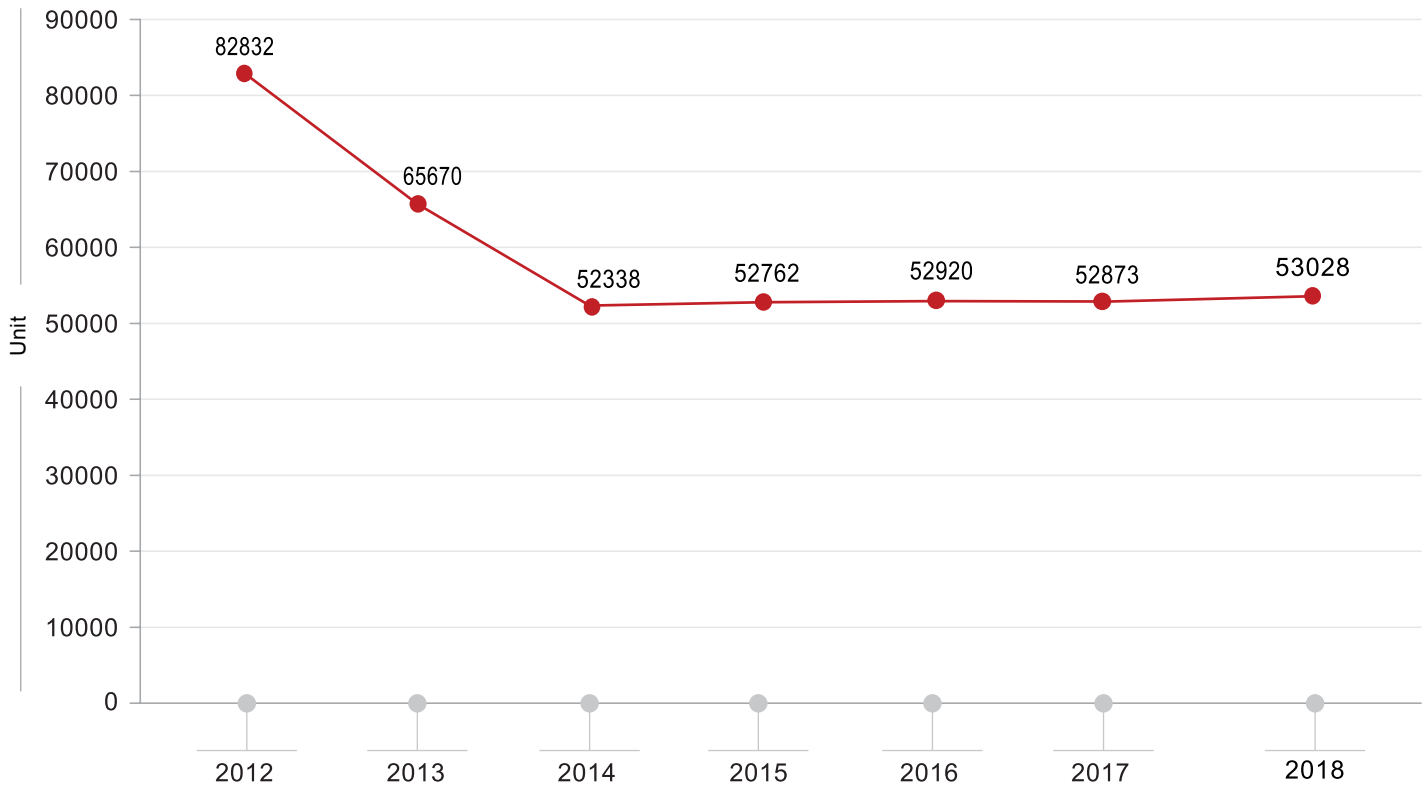
The biggest share in entire production value structure belongs to Health care and social work (26.5%), other services (23.4%), arts, entertainment and recreation (15.0%), education (14.6%), professional, scientific and technical activities (12.9%).

The number of employed persons of Non-profit institutions in 2018 comparably to 2017 has been increased by 0.3% and it amounted to 53.0 thousand of which 53.3 % female and 46.7 male.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYED PERSONS IN NON-PROFIT INSTITUTIONS



The biggest share in entire employment structure belongs to education sector (29.2%), arts, entertainment and recreation (23.0%), Health care and social work (14.6%), rest of share is distributed on other sectors.

From the total employed persons 52.3 thousand were hired (of which 53.1% is female). Number of hired persons in 2018 comparable to 2017 increased by 1.7%.
