### DOMESTIC PRODUCER PRICE INDEX FOR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS IN GEORGIA

SEPTEMBER 2019

In September 2019 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) increased by 0.8 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period the prices went up for manufactured products by 0.8 percent and for electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water by 1.0 percent.

Compared to September 2018 the DPPI increased by 10.4 percent. There was an increase in the prices for manufactured products (12.6 percent), products from mining and quarrying (4.6 percent), also for electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water (1.9 percent).

The following table shows the DPPI for September 2019, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.

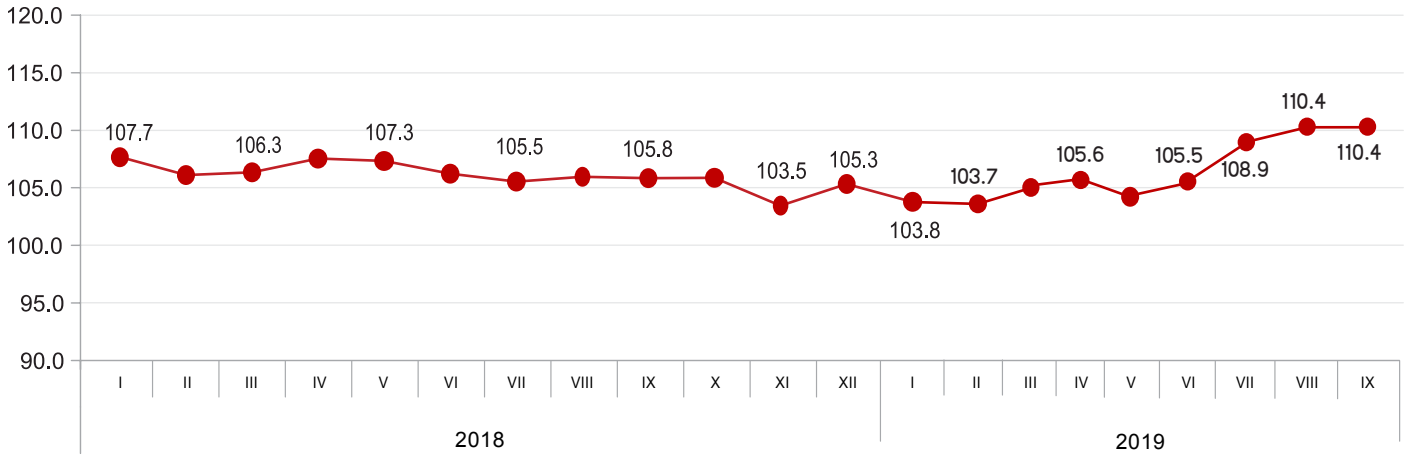
