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**EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA  
SEPTEMBER 2019**

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 1.4 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 1.2 percent increase in the prices for manufactured products.

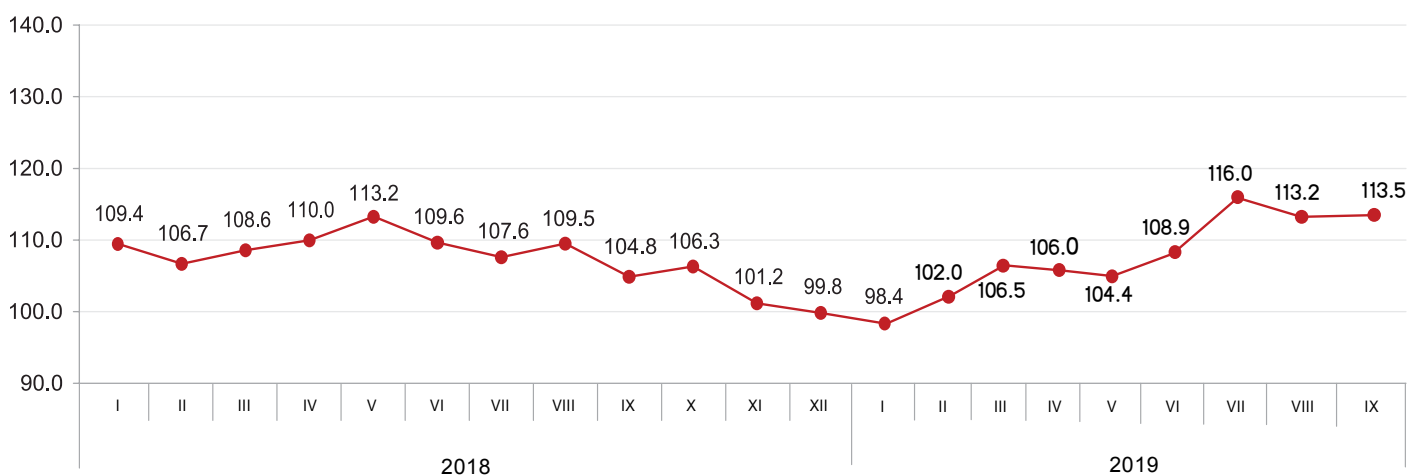
Compared to September 2018 the XPI increased by 13.5 percent. In the mentioned period prices increased for manufactured products by 10.1 percent and for products from mining and quarrying by 39.3 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for September 2019, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
