IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA SEPTEMBER 2019

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 1.1 percent over the previous month, while compared to September 2018 the Index increased by 11.7 percent.

Compared to September 2018 the prices were 10.7 percent higher for manufactured products, while for products from mining and quarrying a price increase of 18.9 percent was registered. With regard to electrical energy, gas, steam and hot water, the prices were 49.0 percent higher.

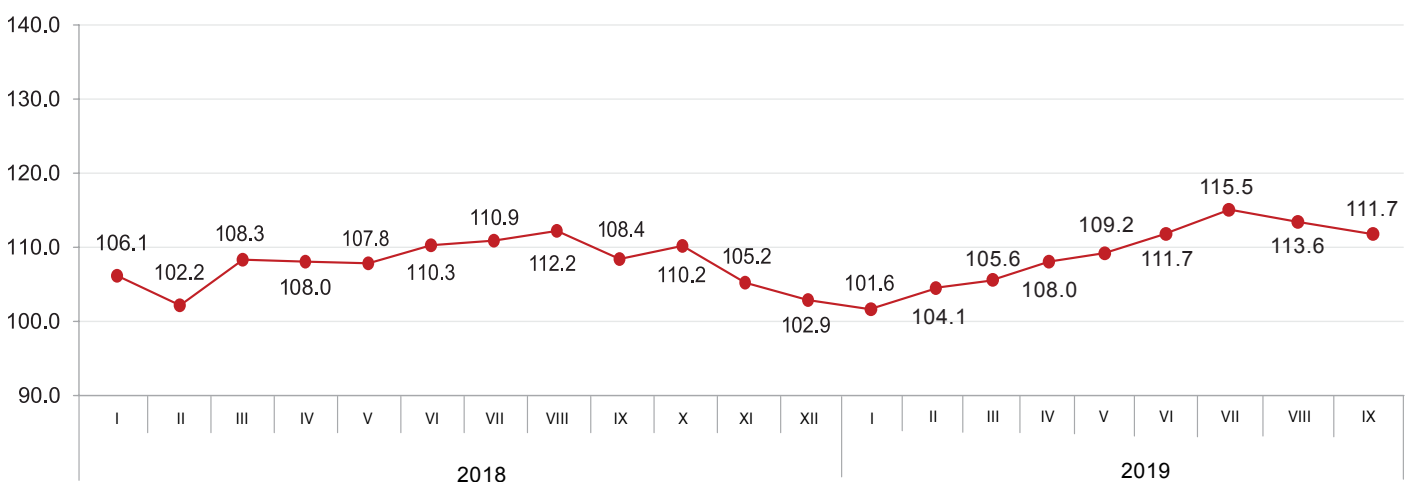
The following table shows the MPI for September 2019, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
