## Key Messages

- The response rates for the - $3 \%$ of children under 17 years live questionnaires of households, children aged 5-17 and children under 5 are $89 \%$ or more.
- 1578 child's blood was extracted for lead test, which is almost 60 percent of eligible amount.

- The average family size is 3.4 . One third of the population (34\%) lives in Tbilisi.
- The $96 \%$ of children under 17 years has health insurance.
