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EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA NOVEMBER 2019

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 1.0 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 1.2 percent increase in the prices for manufactured products.

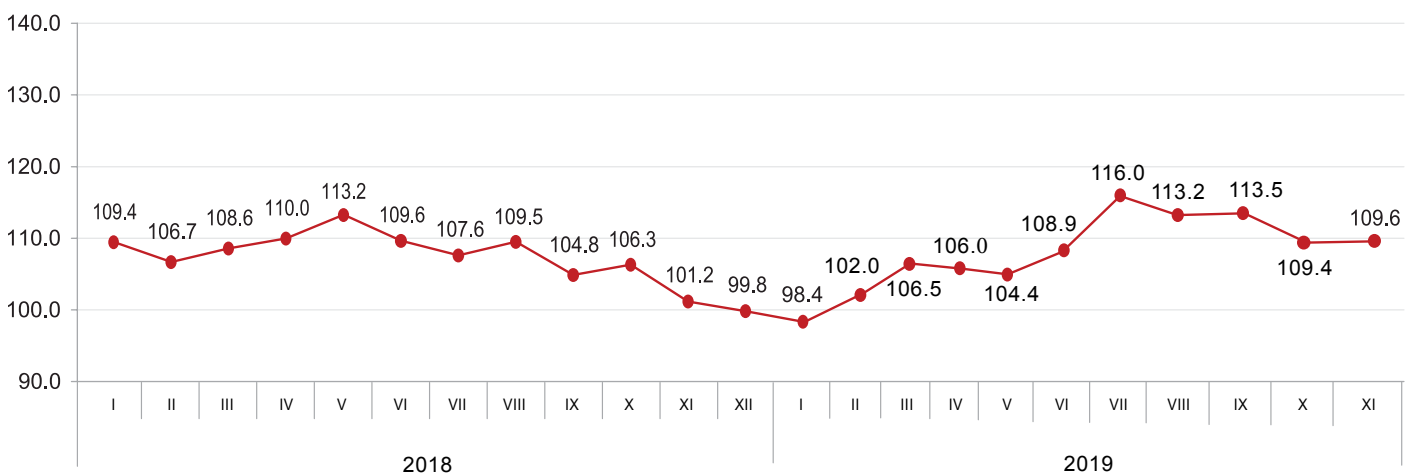
Compared to November 2018 the XPI increased by 9.6 percent. In the mentioned period prices increased for manufactured products by 6.7 percent and for products from mining and quarrying by 30.7 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for November 2019, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
