DOMESTIC PRODUCER PRICE INDEX FOR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS IN GEORGIA FEBRUARY 2020

In February 2020 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) decreased by 0.1 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period the prices for Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air Conditioning decreased by 0.9 percent.

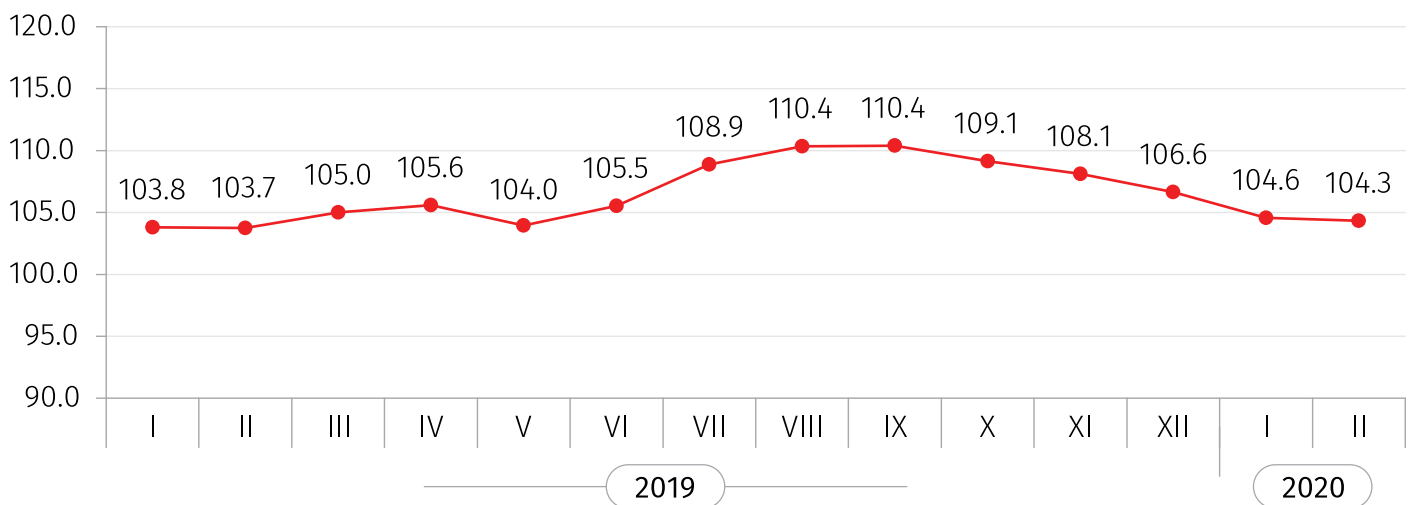
Compared to February 2019 the DPPI increased by 4.3 percent. The prices went up for Mining and Quarrying products by 14.8, for manufactured products by 4.7 percent and for products from Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air Conditioning by 5.8 percent.

The following table shows the DPPI for February 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
