**EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA**

FEBRUARY 2020

The Export Price Index (XPI) decreased by 0.8 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 0.9 percent decrease in the prices for manufactured products.

Compared to February 2019 the XPI increased by 10.5 percent. In the mentioned period prices increased for manufactured products by 8.0 percent and for products from mining and quarrying by 29.4 percent.

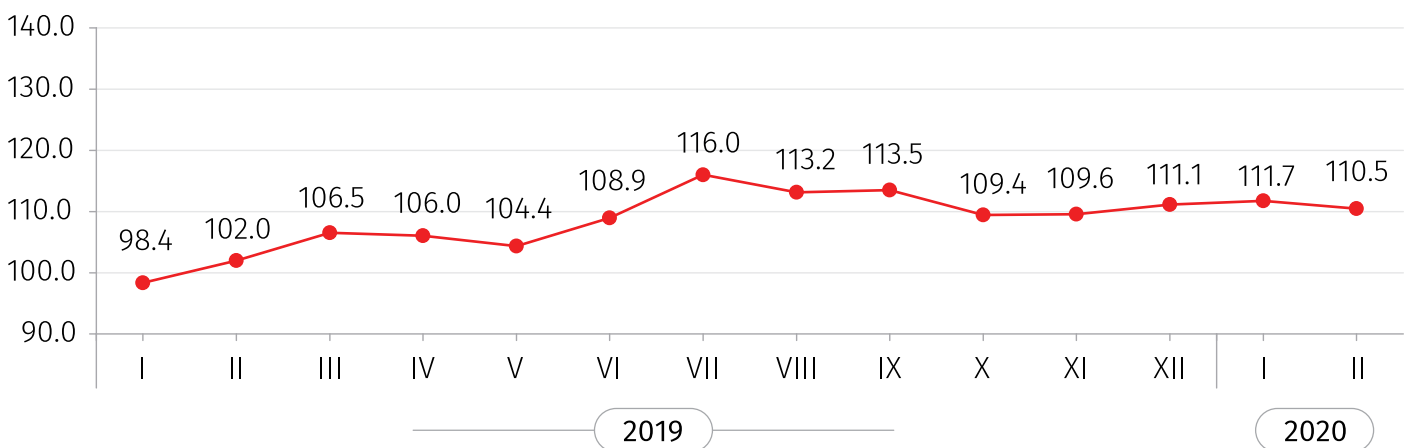
The following table shows the XPI for February 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
