EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

MARCH 2020

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 3.9 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 4.4 percent increase in the prices for manufactured products.

Compared to March 2019 the XPI increased by 12.8 percent. In the mentioned period prices increased for manufactured products by 10.7 percent and for products from mining and quarrying by 27.9 percent.

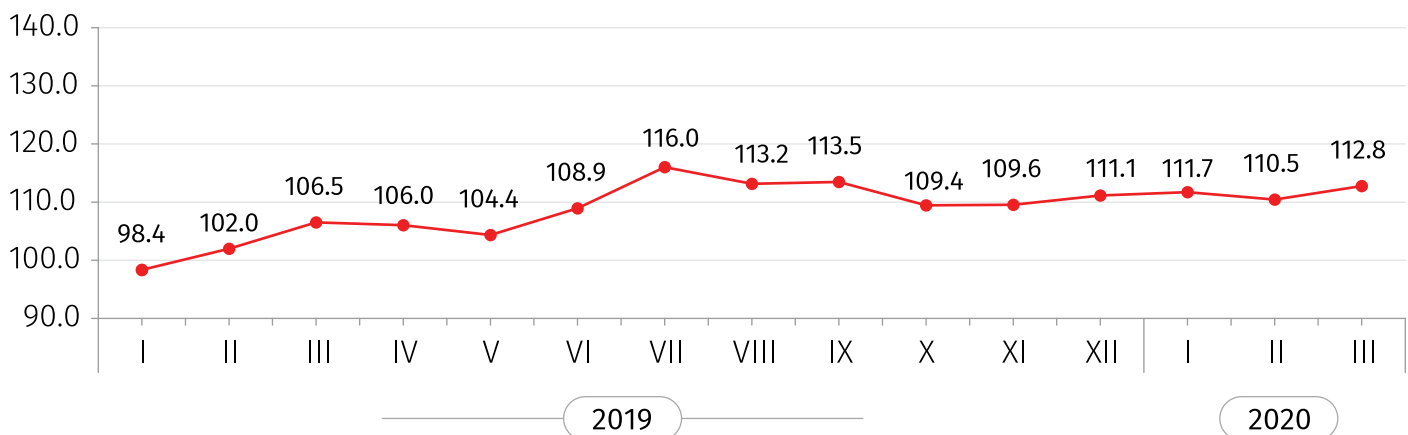
The following table shows the XPI for March 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.
