IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA MARCH 2020

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 5.4 percent over the previous month, while compared to March 2019 the Index increased by 11.0 percent.

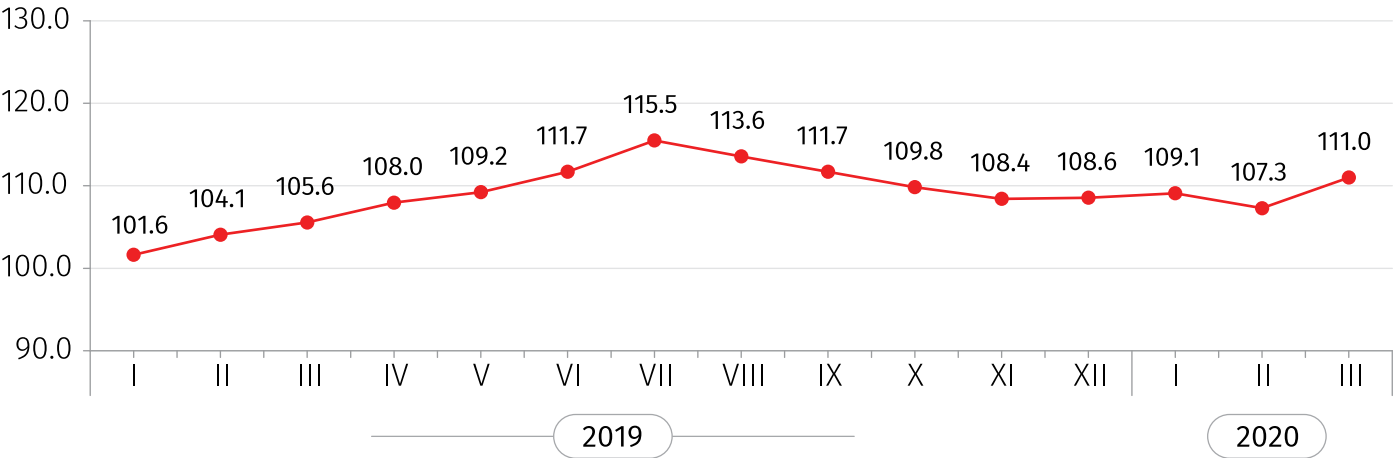
Compared to March 2019 the prices were 10.3 percent higher for manufactured products, while for products from mining and quarrying a price increase of 17.3 percent was registered. With regard to electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning, the prices were 16.3 percent lower.

The following table shows the MPI for March 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index:
