EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

MAY 2020

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 4.5 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 3.3 percent increase in the prices for manufactured products, while for products from mining and quarrying the prices were 17.2 percent higher.

Compared to May 2019 the XPI increased by 19.9 percent. In the mentioned period the prices increased for manufactured products by 16.8 percent and for products from mining and quarrying by 50.8 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for May 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index.

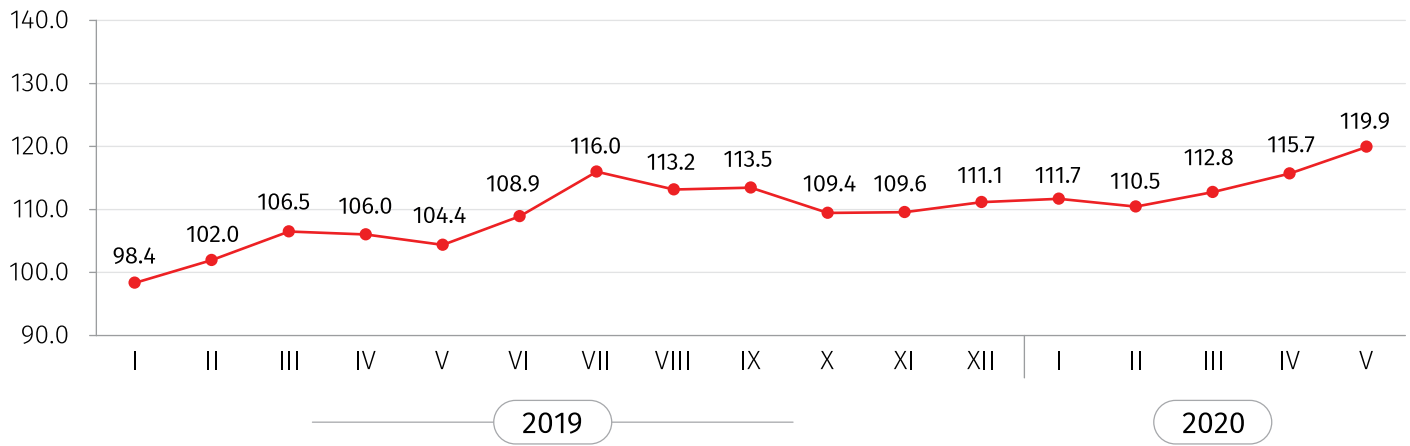
