By the end of 2019, Ministry of Justice has launched the new version of criminal case management system (Crimcase-2), which was adopted by invetigative entities gradually, based on a pre-agreed schedule. Since the integration of the new system is on-going, till its fully implemented, processing of statistics is underway in a pilot regime and is being tested. Current statistics are derived using both modules (Crimcase-1 and Crimcase-2).
