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
EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA **IN JANUARY-JULY 2020**

(PRELIMINARY)

In January-July 2020 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 6 030.6 million, 17.6 percent lower to the same period of 2019. The exports 1 758.5 million (16.8 percent lower), while the imports stood at USD 4 272.1 million equaled USD (17.9 percent lower). The negative trade balance was USD 2 513.6 million in January-July 2020 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 41.7 percent.






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SHARE OF EXTERNAL TRADE INDICATORS IN TURNOVER JANUARY-JULY 2015-2020



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In January-July 2020 the share of the top ten trading partners by exports in the total exports of Georgia amounted to 77.2 percent. The top partners were China (USD 248.3 million), Azerbaijan (USD 230.7 million) and Russia (USD 229.1 million).




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TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-JULY 2019-2020 (MILLION US DOLLARS)




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TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-JULY 2019-2020

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In January-July 2020 the share of the top ten trading partners in the total external trade turnover of Georgia amounted to 70.0 percent. The top trading partners were Turkey (USD 843.3 million), Russia (USD 702.1 million) and China (USD 627.6 million).



In January-July 2020 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 391.3 million or 22.3 percent of total exports. The exports of motor cars totaled USD 198.5 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 11.3 percent. The Ferroalloys exports occupied the third place standing at USD 130.1 million and constituting 7.4 percent of the total exports.



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

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The top import commodities in January-July 2020 were motor cars whose imports equaled USD 383.4 million (9.0 percent of the total imports). The Copper ores and concentrates followed in the list with USD 290.8 million or 6.8 percent of imports. The petroleum and petroleum oils were third in the top import commodity list with USD 278.6 million (6.5 percent of imports).


