EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

JULY 2020

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 0.2 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 7.8 percent increase in the prices for mining and quarrying products.

Compared to July 2019 the XPI increased by 10.9 percent. In the mentioned period prices increased for manufactured products by 8.9 percent and for products from mining and quarrying by 33.1 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for July 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index:

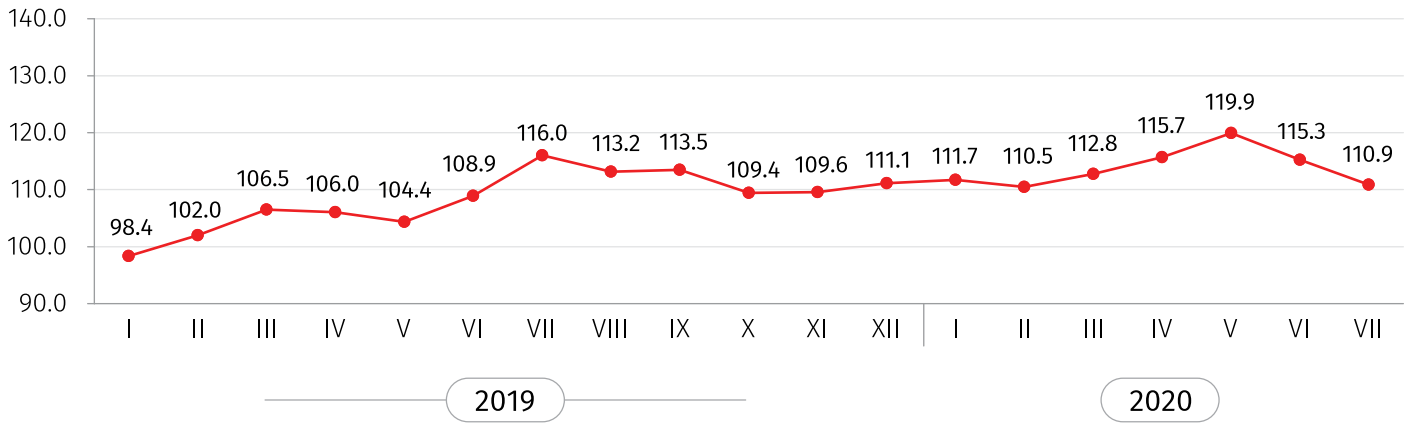
