MAIN INDICATORS OF NON-PROFIT INSTITUTIONS

2019

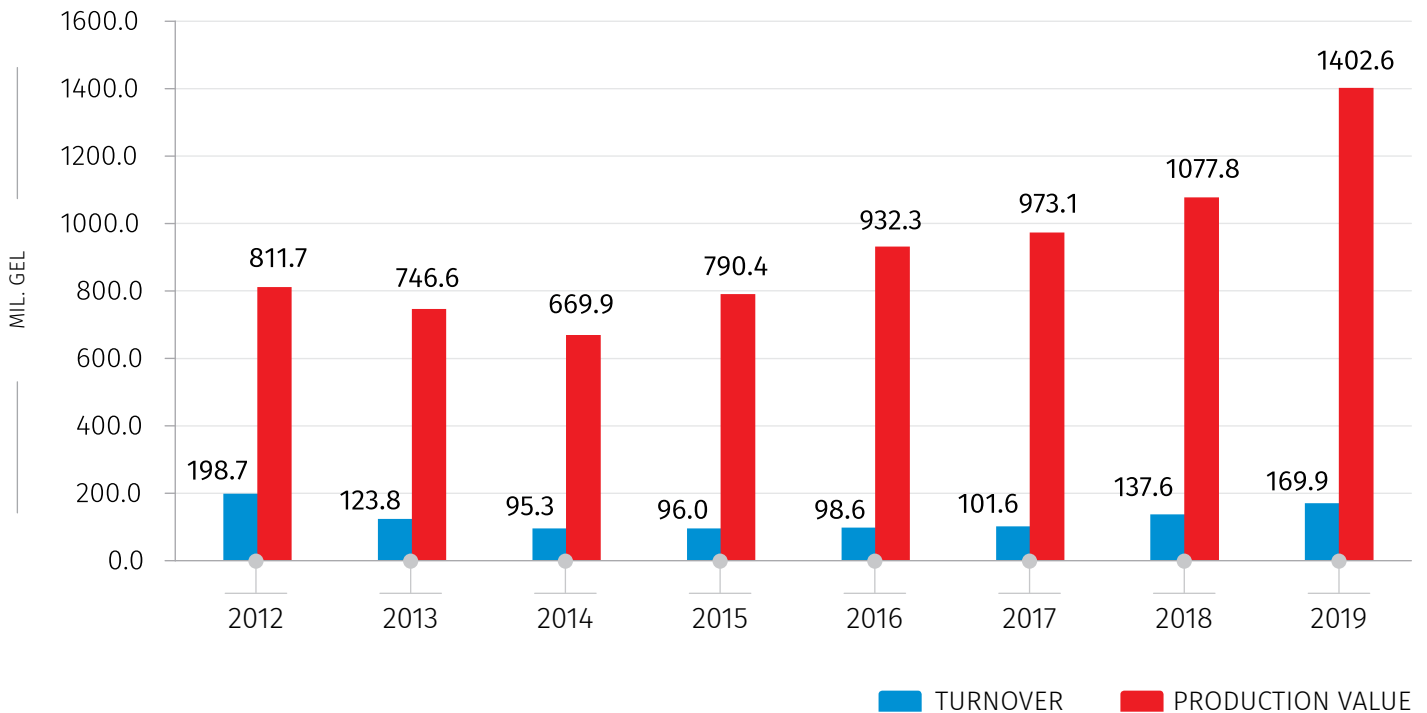
(COMPARISONS ARE MADE BY ACTUAL PRICES)

The Non-profit institutions are legal entities or organizations which produce goods and services and are not focused to receive financial profit. The main part of goods and services produced by Non-profit institutions are distributed free of charge or in not significant prices. The mentioned organizations mostly are on self-financing or membership fees. The financial and non-financial assets can be considered as income of Non-profit institutions. They are encouraged to make an additional economic activity.

By the declared data of 2019 the turnover from auxiliary activities of Non-profit institutions has been amounted 169.9 mil. Georgian Lari, Which 23.3% higher compared to previous year:

The biggest share in entire structure of turnover belongs to education (36.9%), arts, entertainment and recreation (21.0%), Health care and social work (18.6%), other services (7.7%), professional, scientific and technical activities (7.5%) and information and communication activities (4.1%).

Turnover increased about 2.2 times in the wholesale and retail trade, repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles activities, 2 times in the water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities, 1.9 times in the professional, scientific and technical activities, 43.8 % in the arts, entertainment and recreation activities, 30.8% in the transportation and storage activities and 25.2 % in the education sector.

The production value (of goods and services) of Non-profit institutions has been amounted 1402.6 mil. Georgian Lari, Which 30.1% higher compared to previous year.

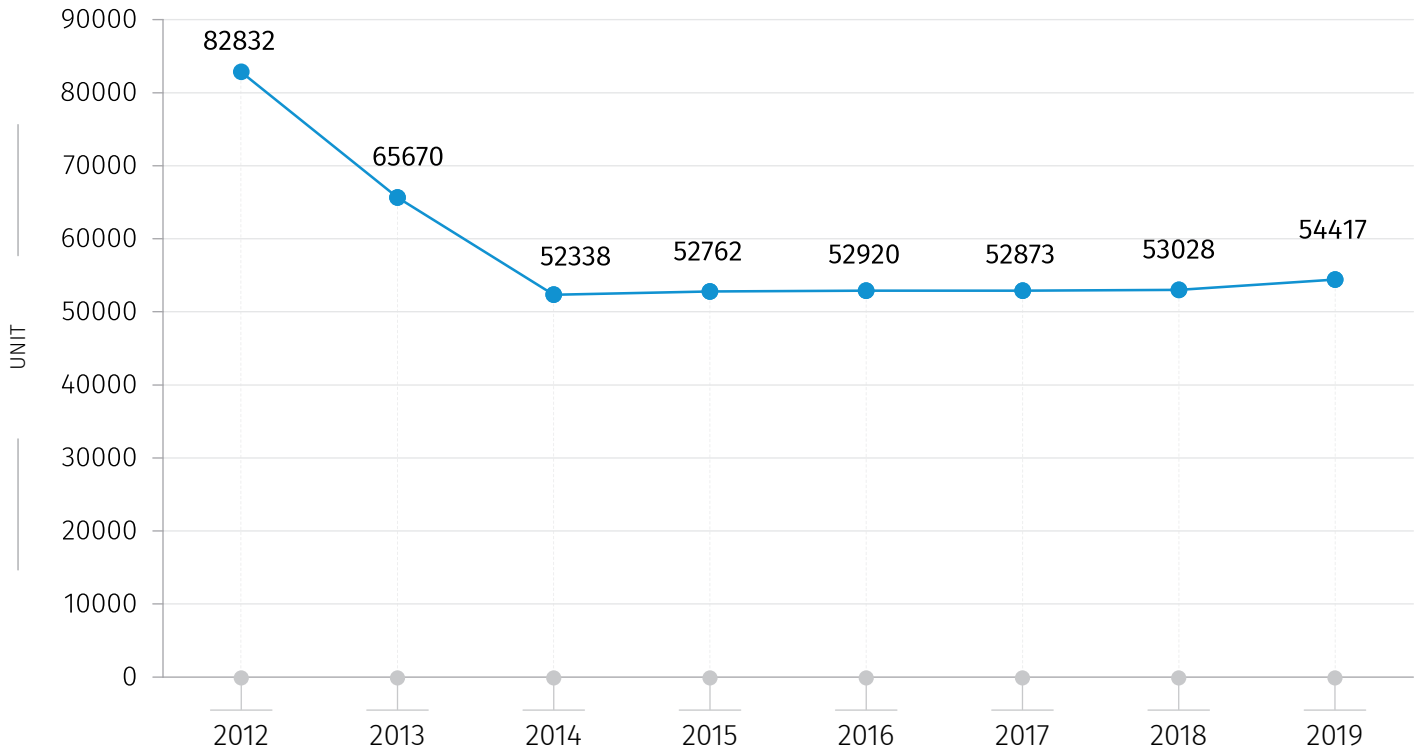
The biggest share in entire production value structure belongs to Health care and social work (28.9%), other services (20.6%), arts, entertainment and recreation (16.1%), education (13.5%), professional, scientific and technical activities (13.1%).

The number of employed persons of Non-profit institutions in 2019 comparably to 2018 has been increased by 2.6% and it amounted to 54.4 thousand of which 53.2 % female and 46.8 % male.

NUMBER OF EMPLOYED PERSONS IN NON-PROFIT INSTITUTIONS



The biggest share in entire employment structure belongs to education sector (28.8%), arts, entertainment and recreation (22.5%), Health care and social work (14.4%), rest of share is distributed on other sectors.

From the total employed persons 53.7 thousand were hired (of which 53.3% is female). Number of hired persons in 2019 comparable to 2018 increased by 2.8%.
