
**AVERAGE MONTHLY NOMINAL EARNINGS OF EMPLOYEES  
(2019)**

In 2019, the average monthly nominal earnings of employees increased by 5.7 percent (61.2 Gel) compared to 2018 and amounted to 1 129.5 Gel.

The chart below presents the distribution of the average monthly nominal earnings of employees in 2001-2019 years.

In 2019, the average monthly earnings increased almost in all sectors compared to 2018. According to the economic activity the highest monthly earnings were observed in the following fields:


- Financial and insurance activities – 2 030.2 Gel (decreased by 9.2 percent compared to the previous year);
- Professional, scientific and technical activities – 1 896.0 Gel (increased by 10.7 percent compared to the previous year);
- Construction - 1 631.1 Gel (increased by 5.1 percent compared to the previous year)


**AVERAGE MONTHLY EARNINGS BY ECONOMIC ACTIVITY**

In 2019, the average monthly earnings equaled to 869.1 Gel for women, while - 1 361.8 Gel for men. The annual growth of earnings amounted to 5.7 percent for women and 6.3 percent for men, respectively. In the majority of sectors of economic activities the average monthly earnings of men were higher compared to women.

The chart below presents the distribution of the average monthly nominal earnings of employees by sex in 2001-2019 years.

(GEL)**




In 2019, the average monthly nominal earning of employees in public sector was 237.4 Gel lower compared to the employees in non-public sector. In addition, compared to 2018, the average monthly earning was increased by 9.1 percent in public sector, while it was increased by 4.1 percent in non-public sector and amounted to 973.7 and 1 211.1 Gel, respectively.


**AVERAGE MONTHLY EARNINGS IN PUBLIC

In 2019, the average monthly earnings of employees in business sector increased by 5.5 percent and equaled to 1 161.7 Gel. According to the economic activity, the highest monthly earnings were observed in the professional, scientific and technical activities (2 104.5 Gel, increased by 10.2 percent compared to the previous year) and in the construction (1 641.8 Gel, increased by 5.2 percent) sectors.

The chart below presents the distribution of the average monthly nominal earnings of employees in business sector in 2007-2019.


**AVERAGE MONTHLY EARNINGS IN BUSINESS SECTOR

In 2019, the average monthly earnings of employees in non-business and financial sector increased by 6.0 percent compared to the previous year and amounted to 1 068.5 Gel. According to the economic activity the highest monthly earnings were observed in the financial and insurance activities as well as in the public administration and defense sectors.

The chart below presents the distribution of the average monthly nominal earnings of employees in non-business and financial Sector in 2007-2019 years.

(GEL)**




Tbilisi and Adjara A.R. are leading regions by amount of the average earning.
