DOMESTIC PRODUCER PRICE INDEX FOR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS IN GEORGIA SEPTEMBER 2020

In September 2020 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) increased by 1.7 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period the prices for manufactured products were 1.2 percent higher.

Compared to September 2019 the DPPI increased by 4.8 percent. The prices went up for manufactured products by 5.7 and for products from electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning by 8.6 percent. In the same period the prices for products from mining and quarrying decreased by 6.3 percent.

The following table shows the DPPI for September 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index:

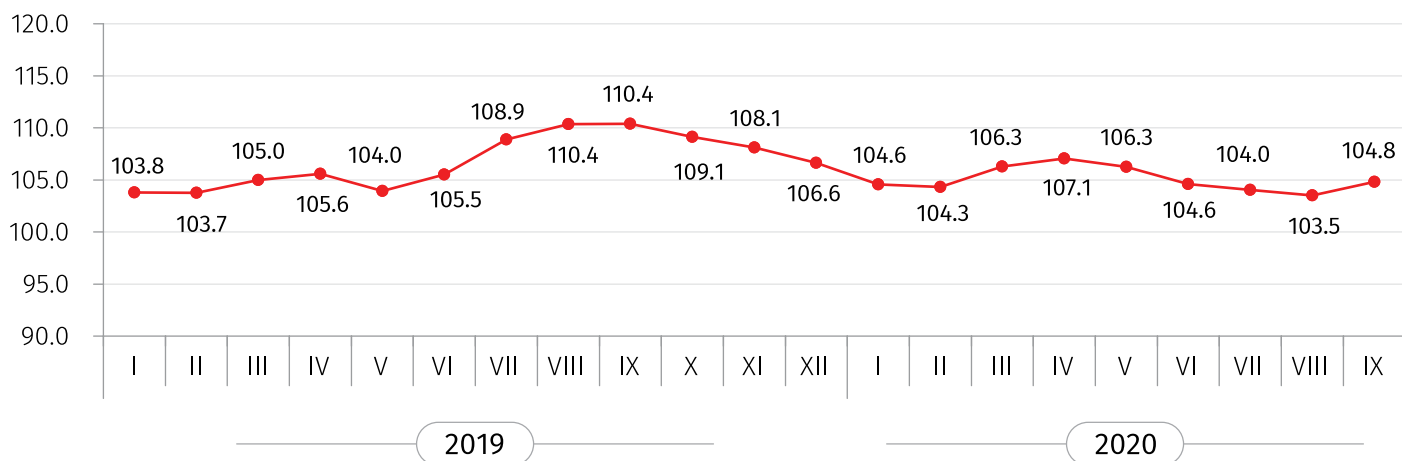
