IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

OCTOBER 2020

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 0.1 percent over the previous month, while compared to October 2019 the index increased by 3.3 percent.


Compared to October 2019 the prices were 4.4 percent higher for manufactured products, while for products from mining and quarrying a price decrease of 8.8 percent was registered. With regard to electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning, the prices were 9.2 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for October 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of sub-groups that had a major effect on the index:
