DOMESTIC PRODUCER PRICE INDEX FOR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS IN GEORGIA

NOVEMBER 2020

In November 2020 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) increased by 2.8 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period the prices for manufactured products were 3.0 percent higher.

Compared to November 2019 the DPPI increased by 8.9 percent. The prices went up for manufactured products by 10.7 and for products from electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning by 4.7 percent. In the same period prices for products from mining and quarrying decreased by 5.9 percent.

The following table shows the DPPI for November 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:


