EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

DECEMBER 2020

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 0.6 percent compared to the previous month. There was a 0.6 percent increase in the prices for manufactured products.

Compared to December 2019 the XPI increased by 13.5 percent. In the mentioned period prices increased for manufactured products by 9.4 percent and for products from mining and quarrying by 41.9 percent.

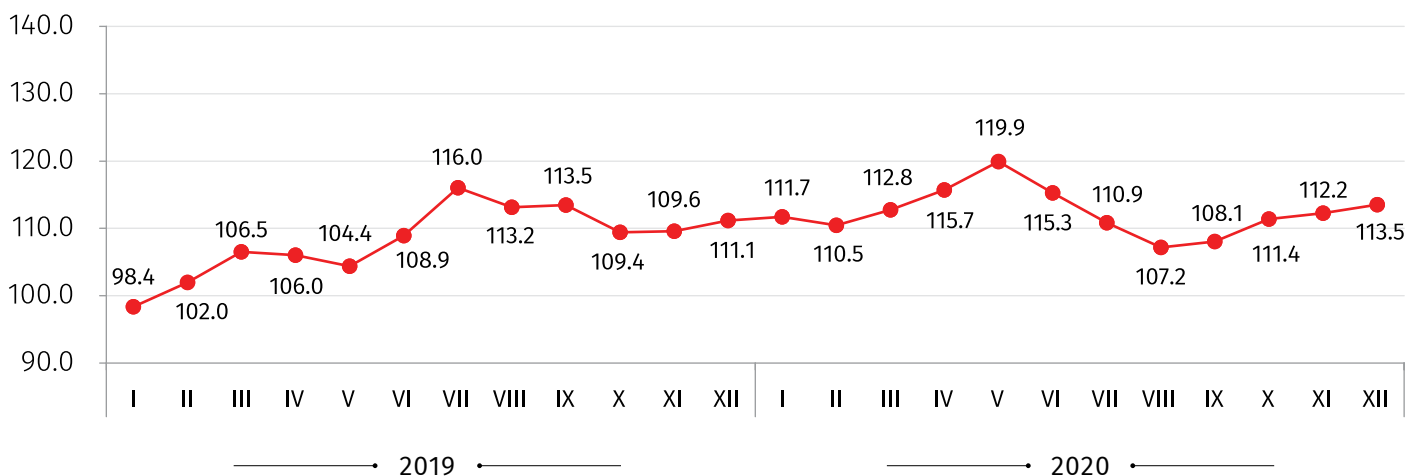
The following table shows the XPI for December 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:
