DOMESTIC PRODUCER PRICE INDEX FOR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS IN GEORGIA

JANUARY 2021

In January 2021 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) increased by 4.4 percent compared to the previous month. In the mentioned period the prices for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning were 15.8 percent higher.

Compared to January 2020 the DPPI increased by 15.7 percent. The prices went up for manufactured products by 14.6 percent, for products from electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning by 21.6 percent, for products from water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 7.5 percent and for products from mining and quarrying by 7.3 percent.

The following table shows the DPPI for January 2021, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:


