#### **IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA**

JANUARY 2021

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 4.1 percent over the previous month, while compared to January 2020 the index increased by 16.1 percent.

Compared to January 2020 the prices were 17.2 percent higher for manufactured products. For products from mining and quarrying a price decrease of 0.7 percent was registered, while for water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services the prices increased by 20.5 percent. With regard to electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning, the prices were 71.9 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for January 2021, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:


