IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

FEBRUARY 2021

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 1.2 percent over the previous month, while compared to February 2020 the index increased by 19.4 percent.

Compared to February 2020 the prices were 21.5 percent higher for manufactured products. For products from mining and quarrying a price increase of 1.8 percent was registered, while for water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services prices increased by 49.0 percent. With regard to electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning, the prices were 27.0 percent lower.

The following table shows the MPI for February 2021, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

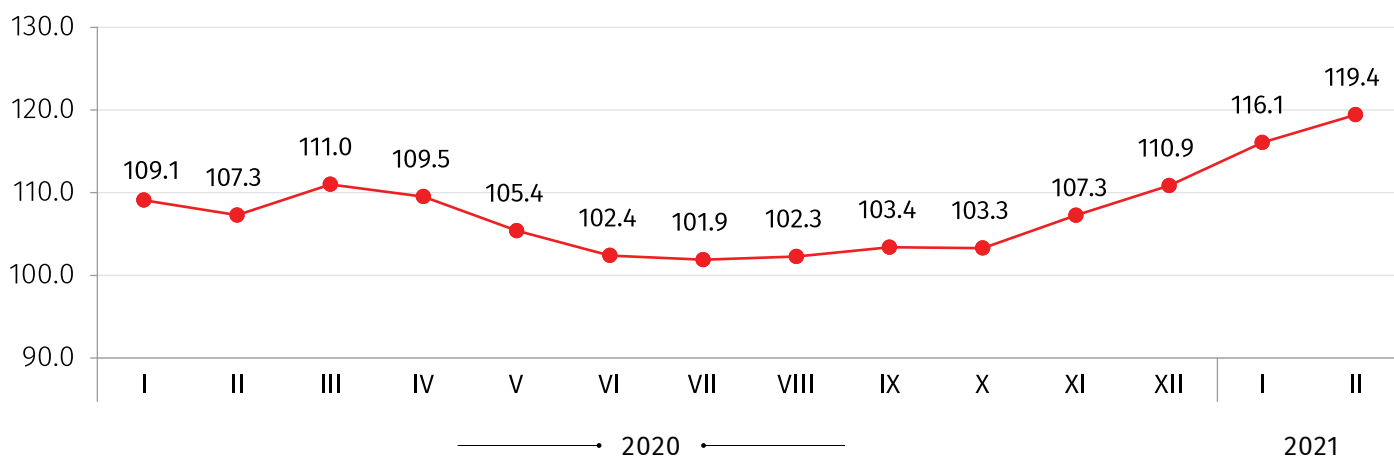
