MAIN RESULTS OF PAWNSHOP SURVEY

(2020 YEAR)

According to the survey results, at the end of 2020 the number of active pawnshops¹ in Georgia amounted to 193 (Without branches), of which 46.1 percent are located in Tbilisi, 14.5 percent in Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti, 14.0 percent in Imereti, 12.4 percent in Adjara, region and 13.0 percent in other regions.

The volume of cash assets in pawnshops at the end of 2020 was equal to GEL 14.3 million, of which 83.6 percent was in national currency and 16.4 percent in foreign currency (see table №1).

The volume of the pawnshop's monetary assets (currency) in banks at the end of 2020 amounted to GEL 14.5 million, of which 50.7 percent was in national currency and 49.3 percent in foreign currency.

The volume of extended loans during 2020 year equaled GEL 322.8 million (of which 87.1 percent in national currency and 12.9 percent - in foreign currency). Physical persons account for 87.5 percent of the overall extended loans, and legal entities - for the remaining 12.5 percent.

The volume of pawnshops' fixed and intangible assets at the end of 2020 totaled GEL 29.7 million.

The volume of the contracted loans in 2020 amounted to GEL 264.8 million, of which 60.8 percent is denominated in national currency, while residents represent the source of 80.2 percent of overall contracted loans.

The value of the annual profit² of the pawnshops stood at GEL 18.4 million, of which 57.0 percent falls on the pawnshops, operating in Tbilisi while the rest are distributed to various regions:



STUCTURE OF PROFIT BY REGIONS, 2020 YEAR




The number of borrowers in the pawnshops in 2020 equaled 307.0 thousand persons, of which the majority (approximately 99,9 percent) are physical entities.

NUMBER OF BORROWERS BY REGIONS, 2020 YEAR




The annual weighted average interest rate on loans equaled 27.8 percent, in the national currency - 27.9 percent, in the foreign currency - 24.3 percent.

The highest annual weighted average interest rate on loans was in Racha-Lechkhumi and Kvemo Svaneti (36.0 percent), but the lowest - in Samtskhe-Djavakheti - (22.3 percent).

ANNUAL WEIGHTED AVERAGE INTEREST RATE ON LOANS BY REGIONS, 2020 YEAR




In terms of the volume of extended loans, the regional distribution was as follows: Tbilisi – 66.3 percent, Adjara - 22.6 percent, Imereti - 4.6 percent, Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti - 4.2 percent and Kvemo Kartli - 1.1 percent.

The analogous picture is present for contracted loans by regions: Tbilisi -70.7 percent, Adjara -21.7 percent, Imereti - 3.4 percent, Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti -2.6 percent and Kvemo Kartli - 0.8 percent.
