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

EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-MARCH 2021 (PRELIMINARY)

In January-March 2021 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 2 773.2 million, 0.3 percent lower to the same period of 2020. The exports equaled USD 820.6 million (5.2 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 1 952.6 million (2.4 percent lower). The negative trade balance was USD 1 131.9 million in January-March 2021 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 40.8 percent.

The charts below reflect basic trends of the external merchandise trade of Georgia:











TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-MARCH 2021








TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-MARCH 2020-2021



EXPORTS IMPORTS

In January-March 2021 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 158.8 million or 19.4 percent of total exports. The exports of motor cars totaled USD 86.6 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 10.5 percent. The ferro-alloys exports occupied the third place standing at USD 83.7 million and constituting 10.2 percent of the total exports.



The top import commodities in January-March 2021 were motor cars whose imports equaled USD 168.5 million (8.6 percent of the total imports). The copper ores and concentrates followed in the list with USD 145.8 million or 7.5 percent of imports. The petroleum and petroleum oils were third in the top import commodity list with USD 141.9 million (7.3 percent of imports).


