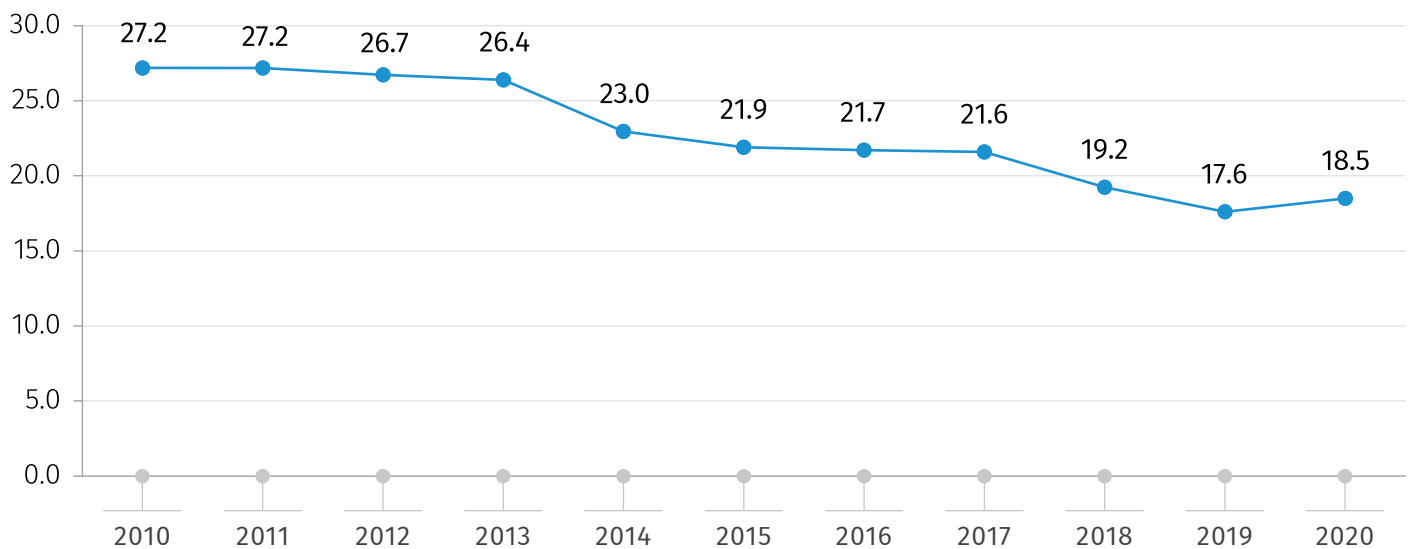
**INDICATORS OF THE LABOUR FORCE
(EMPLOYMENT AND UNEMPLOYMENT)
2020**

In 2020 the unemployment rate in Georgia increased by 0.9 percentage points compared to 2019 and amounted to 18.5 percent.

The chart below presents the unemployment rate by 2010-2020 years.

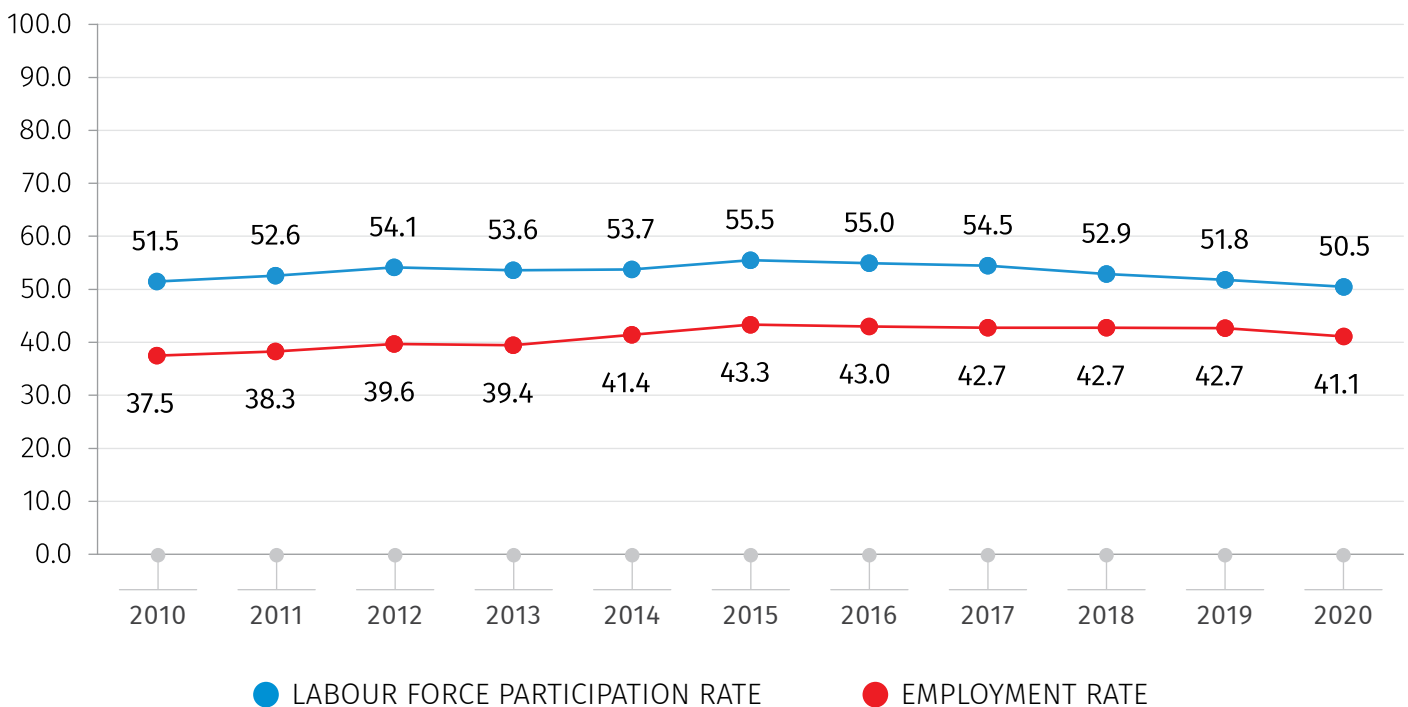
In 2020 labour force (economically active population) constituted 50.5 percent of the working age population (population aged 15 and older). The Labour force participation rate (economic activity rate) declined 1.3 percentage points, while employment rate by 1.5 percentage points compared to the previous year. The Labour force participation rate (economic activity rate) in urban settlements decreased by 0.3 percentage points and by 2.6 percentage points in rural settlements compared to the previous year. The employment rate in urban settlements as well as in rural areas decreased by 1.3 and 1.8 percentage points respectively.

The chart below presents the labour force participation rate (economic activity rate) and employment rates by 2010-2020 years.

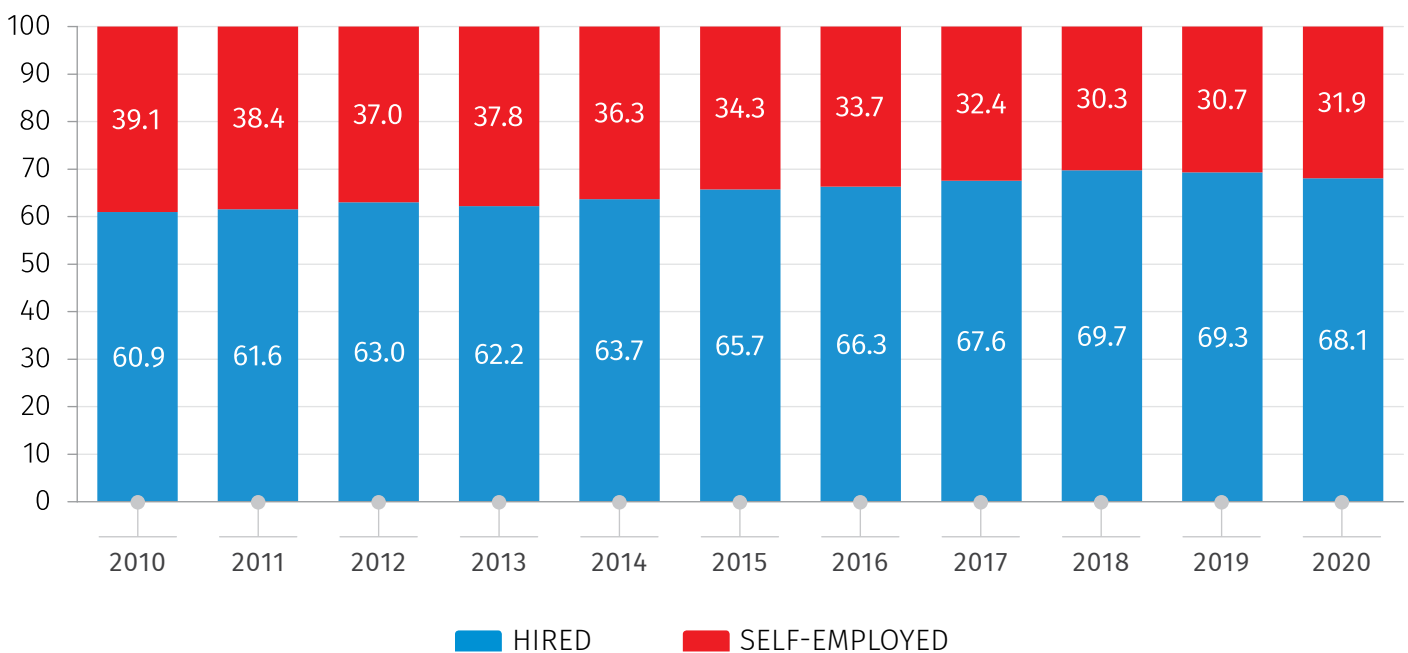
In 2020, the share of hired employees was 68.1 percent among employed persons that decreased by 1.2 percentage points compared to the previous year.

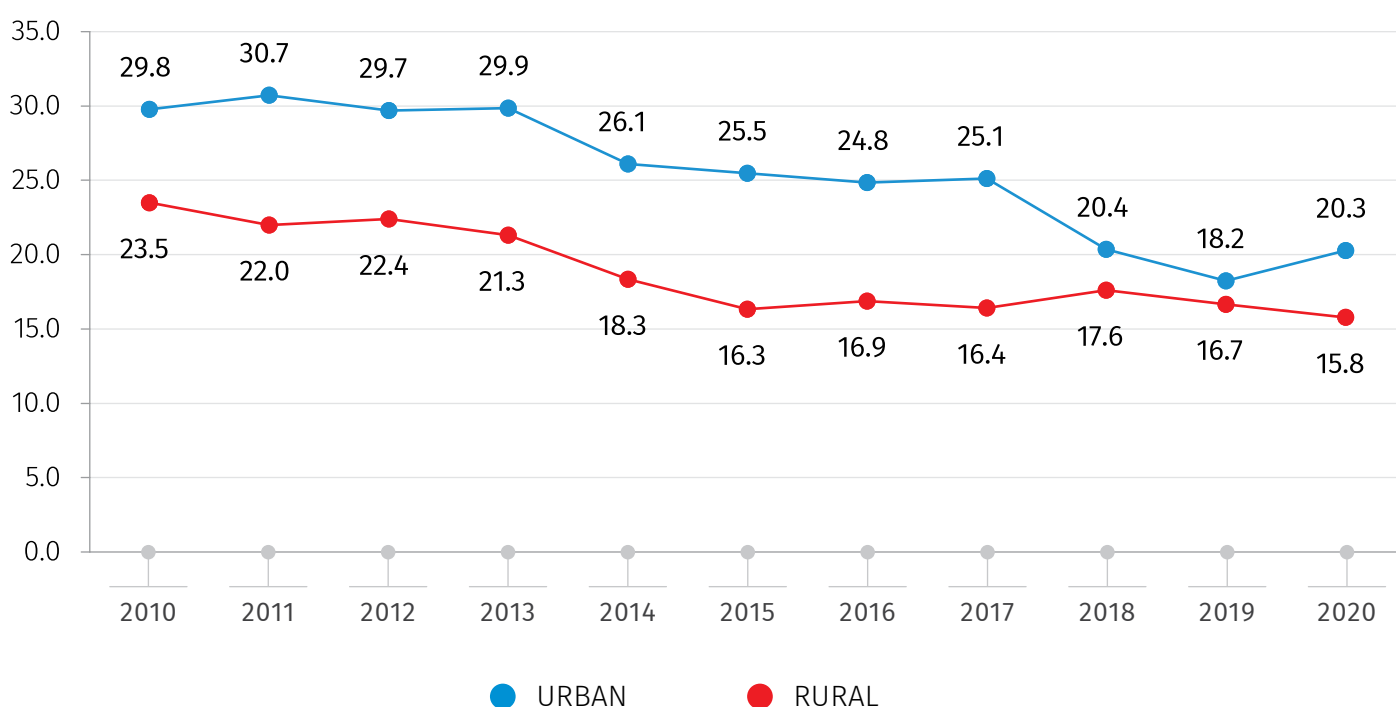
In 2020, the unemployment rate in urban settlements increased by 2.0 percentage points compared to the previous year, while in rural settlements that decreased by 0.9 percentage point.

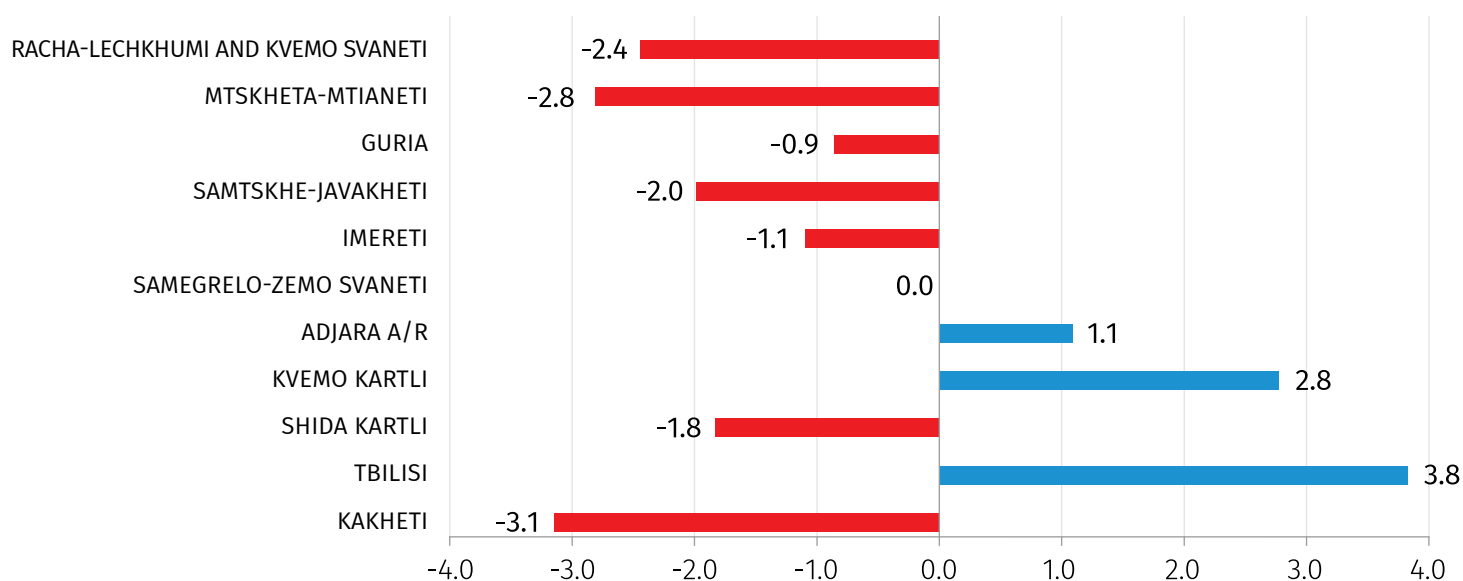

In 2020, compared to the previous year the unemployment rate increased in Tbilisi, Kvemo Kartli and Adjara regions by 3.8, 2.8 and 1.1 percentage points, respectively. The indicator remained unchanged in Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti region, while the unemployment rate declined in the rest regions.

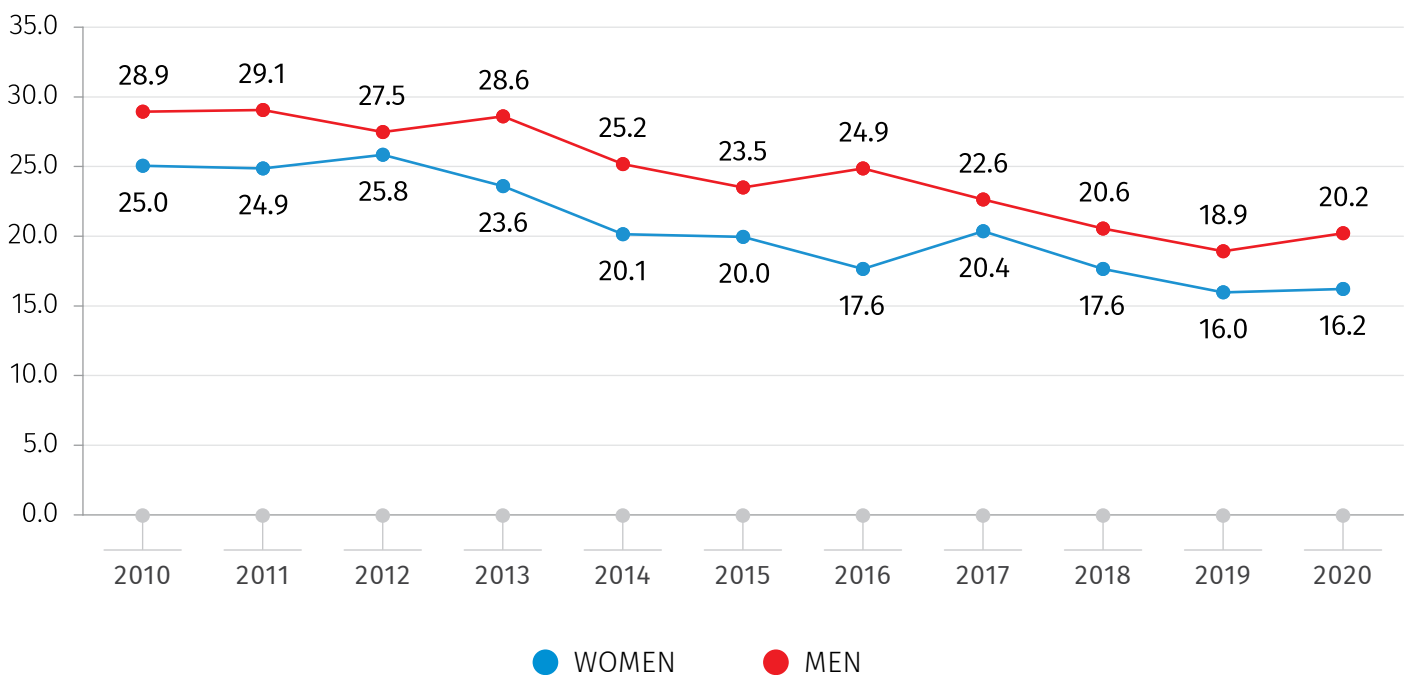
Traditionally, the unemployment rate is higher for men than for women. In 2020, compared to the previous year this indicator increased for women by 0.2 percentage points, while it increased by 1.3 percentage points for men.

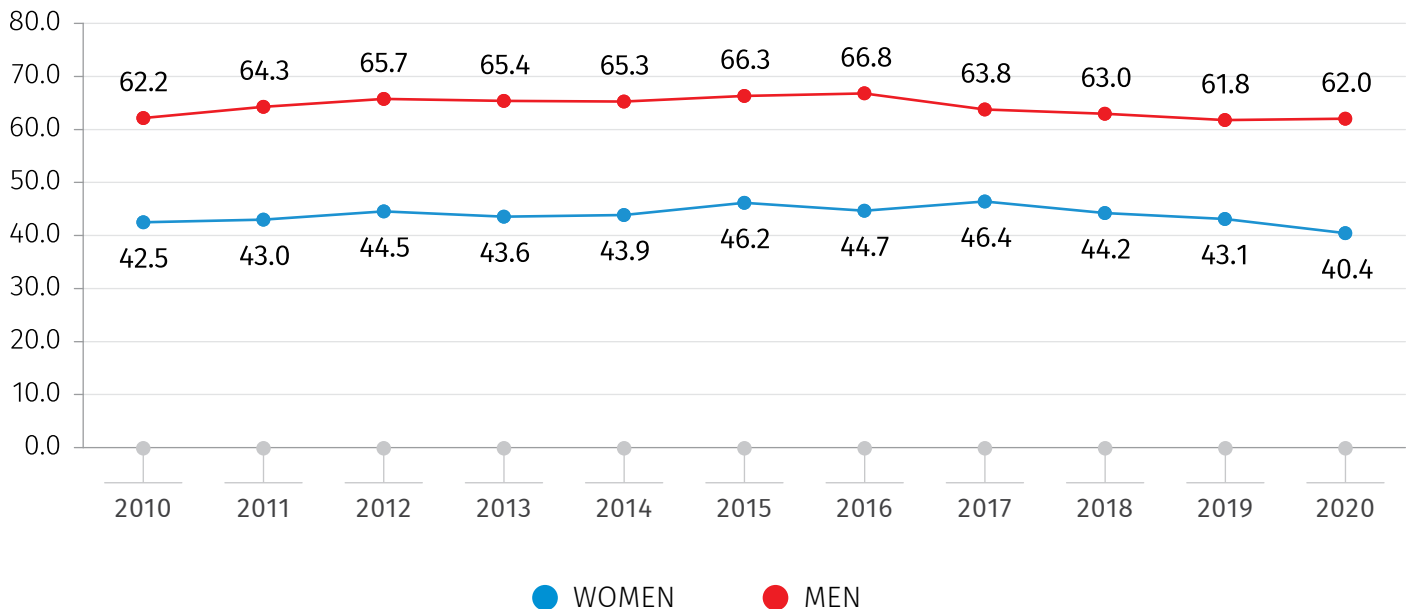

The labour force participation rate (activity rate) is higher for men than for women. In 2020 the indicator for women was 40.4 percent and for men – 62.0 percent. The labour force participation rate (activity rate) for women decreased by 2.7, while that increased by 0.3 percentage points for men, compared to the previous year.

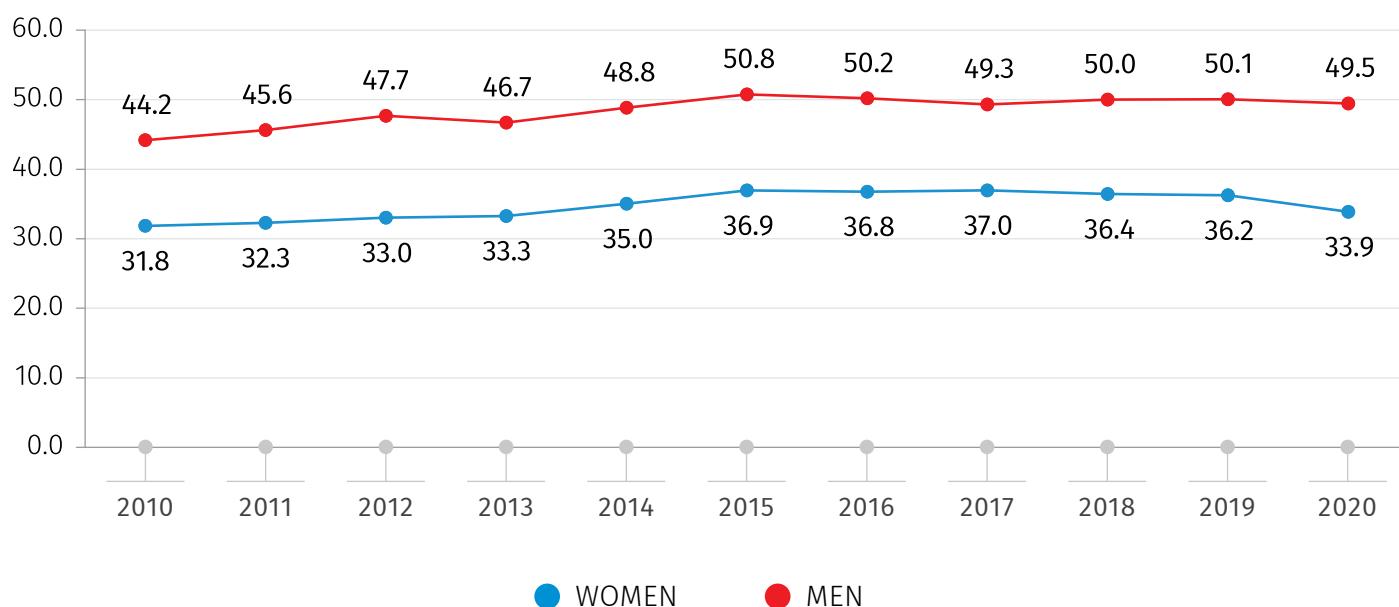
In 2020 the employment rate for women as well as for men decreased by 2.3 and 0.6 percentage points, respectively compared to the previous year.

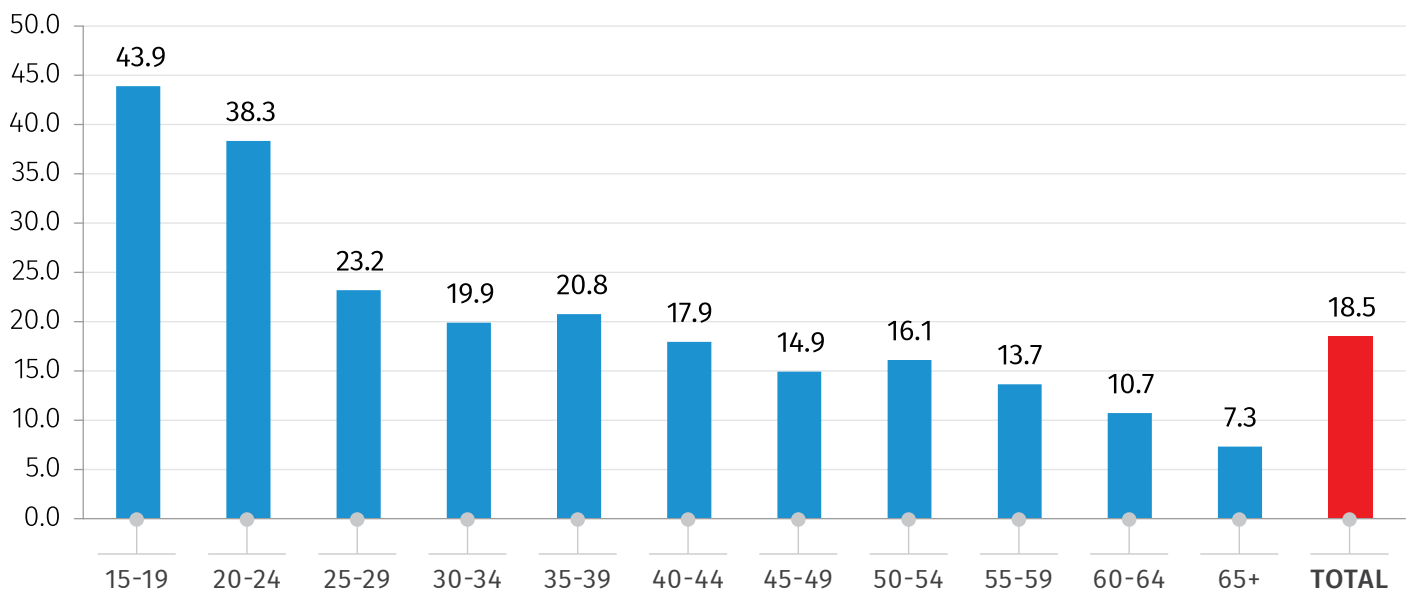
In 2020, the highest rate of unemployment is in the age group of 15-19 years (43.9 percent), while this indicator is traditionally the lowest in the 65+age group (7.3 percent) that is mainly caused by the low rate of labour force participation in this age group.
