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

EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-APRIL 2021

(PRELIMINARY)

In January-April 2021 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 3 928.7 million, 12.8 percent higher to the same period of 2020. The exports equaled USD 1 198.7 million (19.6 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 2 730.0 million (10.1 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 1 531.3 million in January-April 2021 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 39.0 percent.





(MILLION US DOLLARS)




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The diagrams below show the share of the exports and imports of Georgia by country groups.



TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-APRIL 2021










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



In January-April 2021 copper ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 264.1 million or 22.0 percent of total exports. The exports of motor cars totaled USD 125.4 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 10.5 percent. The ferro-alloys exports occupied the third place standing at USD 111.4 million and constituting 9.3 percent of the total exports.



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

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The top import commodities in January-April 2021 were motor cars whose imports equaled USD 244.6 million (9.0 percent of the total imports). The petroleum and petroleum oils followed in the list with USD 196.7 million or 7.2 percent of imports. The copper ores and concentrates were third in the top import commodity list with USD 190.5 million (7.0 percent of imports).


