IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

MAY 2021

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 2.4 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to May 2020 the index increased by 27.2 percent.

Compared to May 2020 the prices were 28.8 percent higher for manufactured products. For products from mining and quarrying a price increase of 12.4 percent was registered, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning prices decreased by 22.0 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 14.6 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for May 2021, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

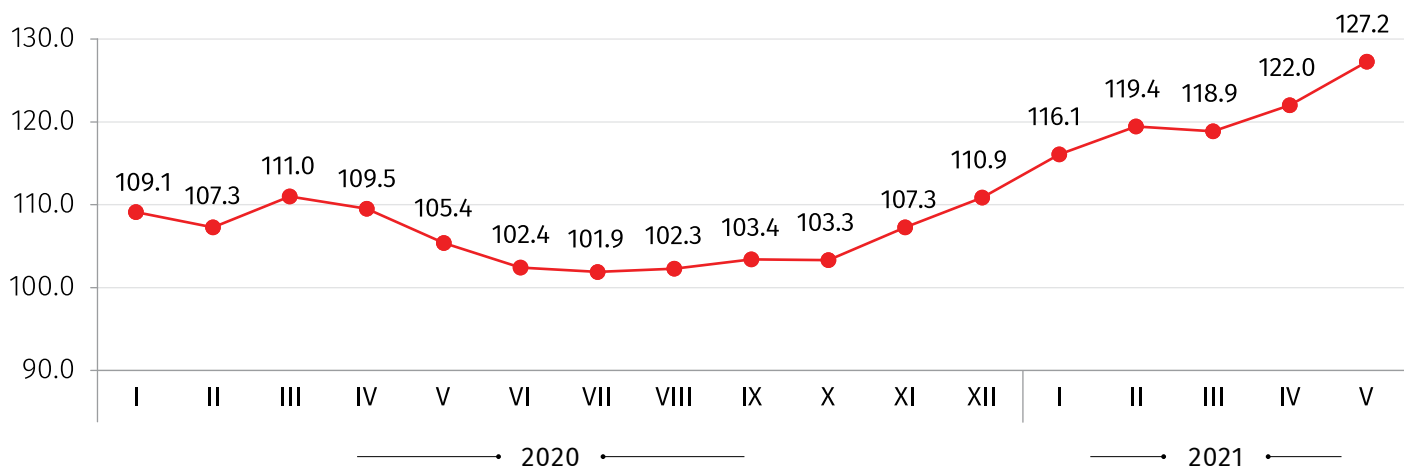
