IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

JULY 2021

The Import Price Index (MPI) decreased by 1.7 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to July 2020 the index increased by 21.9 percent.

Compared to July 2020 the prices were 21.9 percent higher for manufactured products. For products from mining and quarrying a price increase of 18.5 percent was registered, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning prices decreased by 18.6 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 17.9 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for July 2021, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:
