MAIN INDICATORS OF NON-PROFIT INSTITUTIONS 2020


(COMPARISONS ARE MADE BY ACTUAL PRICES)

The Non-profit institutions are legal entities or organizations which produce goods and services and are not focused to receive financial profit. The main part of goods and services produced by Non-profit institutions are distributed free of charge or in not significant prices. The mentioned organizations mostly are on self-financing or membership fees. The financial and non-financial assets can be considered as income of Non-profit institutions. They are encouraged to make an additional economic activity.

By the declared data of 2020 the turnover from auxiliary activities of Non-profit institutions has been amounted 156.0 mil. Georgian Lari, Which 8.0 % less compared to previous year:

The biggest share in entire structure of turnover belongs to education (40.8%), Health care and social work (21.7%), arts, entertainment and recreation (18.7%), professional, scientific and technical activities (7.0%), other services (6.1%) and information and communication activities (2.7%).

Turnover increased about 19.2 times in construction, 13.1 times in the Administrative and support service activities, 5 times in manufacturing. Also, turnover is increased in the Health care and social work (5.8%) and in the water supply, sewerage, waste management, and remediation activities (2.2%) sector.

The production value (of goods and services) of Non-profit institutions has been amounted 1732.9 mil. Georgian Lari, Which 23.6% higher compared to previous year.

The biggest share in entire production value structure belongs to Health care and social work (36.2%), other services (28.1 %), arts, entertainment and recreation (10.3%), education (11.0 %), professional, scientific and technical activities (7.9%).


The number of employees in non-profit organizations in 2020 was 54.2 thousand men, of which 53.4 percent were women and 46.6 percent were men. This figure is slightly lower than in 2019:

The biggest share in entire employment structure belongs to education sector (29.0%), arts, entertainment and recreation (22.2%), Health care and social work (14.6%), rest of share is distributed on other sectors.

From the total employed persons 53.5 thousand were hired (of which 53.6% is female). Number of hired persons in 2020 are insignificant less than last year.
